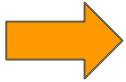

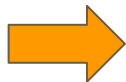

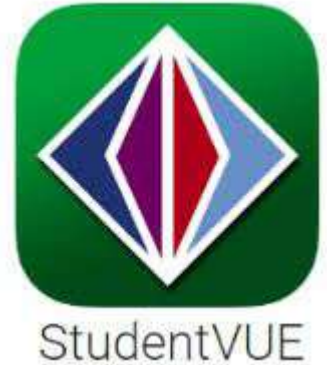


# How to Prepare for Online Forecasting

- Attend the Virtual Drop-In Forecasting Help Sessions
- Email or text your high school counselor to ask questions or to request that they review your course selections

# Forecasting in StudentVUE

- Log-into StudentVUE
  - Believe that you can forecast in the app., but forecasting on a computer might be easier
- Select “Course Requests”
- Select Blue Button “Click here to change course requests”
- Focus on:
  - Add Request
  - Add Alternate
  - Course ID
  - Course Title
- Do not need to save- it saves automatically
