# Parent Involvement: Your Presence Matters

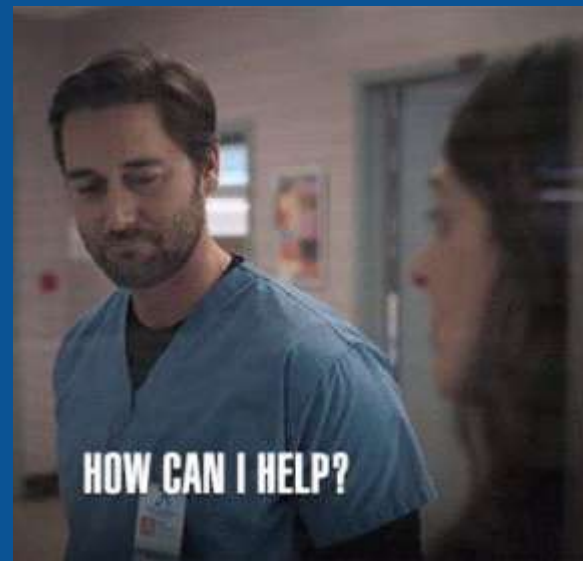
## Among studies, the benefits for students include:

- Passing a minimum of 6 classes all year.



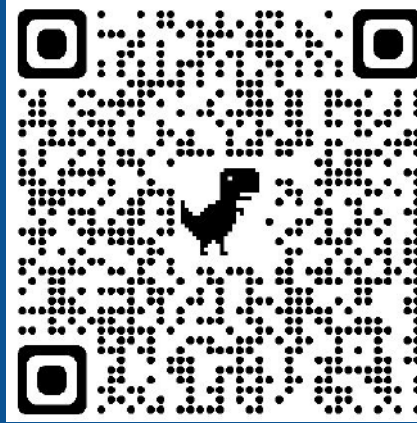
