# Graduation Requirements

- 22 total credits for graduation, including:
- Core Classes:
  - English – 4 credits
  - Math – 4 credits
  - Science – 3 credits (4 recommended for college)
  - Social Studies – 3 credits (4 recommended for college)
- Health (½ credit) and P.E. (½ credit)
- Fine Arts (Visual or Performing) – 1.0 credit
- Personal Finance – 0.5 credit semester class
- Additional credits/electives – 5.5 credits

# The Scheduling Process

## **STEP 1 – Teacher Recommendations**

Classroom teachers are currently completing recommendations for the courses that your student should take next year in English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and World Languages.

For example: Physical Science or Honors Physical Science

## **STEP 2 – Complete the Course Request Form**

This worksheet will be passed out at the initial introductory meetings at the middle schools. Please fill this out and bring it on the schedule request verification day later in January.

# The Scheduling Process

## STEP 2 – Completing the Course Requests Form

- When choosing electives, choose six SEMESTERS of electives
- Spanish I = full year=two semesters
- Art I = one semester
- Study Hall can be taken one or both semesters
- *Include alternates*



# The Scheduling Process

## **Step 3 - Online Course Requests in PowerSchool**

In addition to the course requests form, students should also complete course requests in PowerSchool prior to the Student Scheduling Meetings in Step 4.

## Course Request Changes

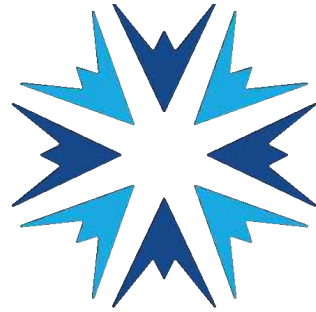


# Club and Extracurricular Involvement
