STEP 4: Entering Course Requests in PowerSchool


- Use course request sheets to enter requests online in PowerSchool

- The last day to enter course requests in PowerSchool is January 24th.





2. Click the pencil for each course group and select all courses you wish to request for the upcoming school year.



In each course group, check the box for the course you wish to request. The course you are recommended for by your current teacher should be at the top of each group. If you do not see a recommendation identified, the teacher in that discipline has not made a recommendation. You may choose any class you wish as long as you meet the required pre-requisites for the given course. Once you select the course click "Okay."

STEP 5: The Scheduling Conference
