If a student is absent on the day of an exam, he/she is expected to take the exam upon returning to class. All test and quiz scores will be made available on the Parent Portal.
- 4) Homework: Homework is assigned every day and due the following school day. Homework will be checked routinely and must be kept in notebook, properly labeled, at all times. Students will also be given assignments from an online application such as Castle Learning or Prodigy Math Game. If a student is absent, the student is required to hand in homework no later than the day after he/she returns to school. After 2 missed homework assignments, a courtesy warning email will be sent to parent (using email provided below).
- 5) Class participation/Notebook: All students must come to class, on time, and with their homework, notebook, calculator and a writing utensil. Coming late or unprepared (missing pen, notebook etc) to class will result in deduction in class participation credits. Students are expected to take notes, try to complete in-class assignments, and to participate constructively in cooperative learning activities. Notebook checks and quizzes will be given at least once a quarter. Each student will leave composition notebook in class to complete individualized learning assignments.
- 6) **Communication**: Students are required to sign up for **Remind** by following instructions given out in class and also found on my website. Parents are also invited to sign up for Remind to receive notifications regarding class assignments, tests or other news. 
