2120 Guidance and Counseling

Permanent employees included under salaries are 1 full time.

Notes:

This function supports the elementary school counselor. The counselor provides counseling and teaching to promote healthy social emotional development of all students. In addition the elementary counselor provides ongoing consultation for parents and teachers.

The counselor is available for all children K-2 at Coffin School. The position serves approximately 372 students.

During he academic year the counselor visits each classroom to provide activities and lessons with a focus upon prevention. Depending upon the developmental needs at each grade level, topics may include but are not limited to friendship skills, bullying prevention, conflict resolution, refusal skills, decision making skills, diversity awareness and personal safety/abuse prevention.

Individual and crisis counseling is provided for student through self-referral, teacher or parent referral. Specialized small groups meet weekly to strengthen social skills and support the needs of at-risk students.

The elementary counselor's role includes attending IEP meetings and meeting with staff and parents to write individual 504 plans for Coffin School. The school counselor is also a member of the RTI team. During the spring and in September the counselor coordinates Kindergarten screening for the district.

The counselor is responsible for making referrals as needed to community mental health providers and the Department of Health and Human Services.

Notes:

The special education resource program serves the needs of kindergarten through second grade students with mild to moderate disabilities requiring special education services for less than 60% of the school day. These disabilities could include autism, specific learning disability, other health impairment, emotional disability, speech or language impairment or a combination of disabilities. This program provides remedial individualized and small group instruction designed to meet each child's specific goals. Academic evaluations of children are also administered at the recommendation of the Individualized Education Program process. I also case manage students receiving behavior resource support.

The resource program provides a continuum of services from academic consultation and support to classroom teachers, monitoring the student's regular educational programming and direct academic instruction in the resource room. This program also acts as a supportive service to children involved in other special education programs, especially those receiving behavior support. The variety and severity of the students' disabilities demonstrates the continued need for support in the academic areas of reading, writing, spelling and math as well as curriculum support in the content areas to ensure student success in the mainstream classroom.

2150 Speech and Language Services

Notes:

The Speech and Language program provides a multi-sensory approach to speech and language development. Students from regular education kindergarten through grade 2 are serviced by this program, as well as multi-handicapped students from the Elementary Functional Skills and the Behavior Resource programs.

A number of areas are addressed in this program: Receptive/expressive language delays, vocabulary and concept knowledge deficits and pragmatic language delays, as well as, hearing impairment and auditory and language processing difficulties. Pre-communication skills for non-verbal students are taught and practice for Picture Exchange Systems and augmentative communication devices is provided. Strategies are taught to children with Central Auditory Processing Disorders, Autism and Hearing Impairment to improve their classroom performance.

An important component of the program is assessment. Each child recommended for the intervention must be evaluative tools must be kept current and new protocols (test booklets) have to be purchased yearly. All children entering the school system are screened in the area of speech/language and phonological awareness; materials must be purchased for this testing.

The budget request reflects computer programs, augmentative communication devises and hands-on supplies to meet the multi-sensory needs of students. Protocols and tests are purchased to provide appropriate testing materials to meet the program guidelines. Books and journals are purchased to keep staff informed of recent research and new ideas for meeting the needs of children. Staff development funds are allocated to allow the therapist to maintain an updated knowledge base of current practices. One consultation form specialists outside for the district as appropriate.
