

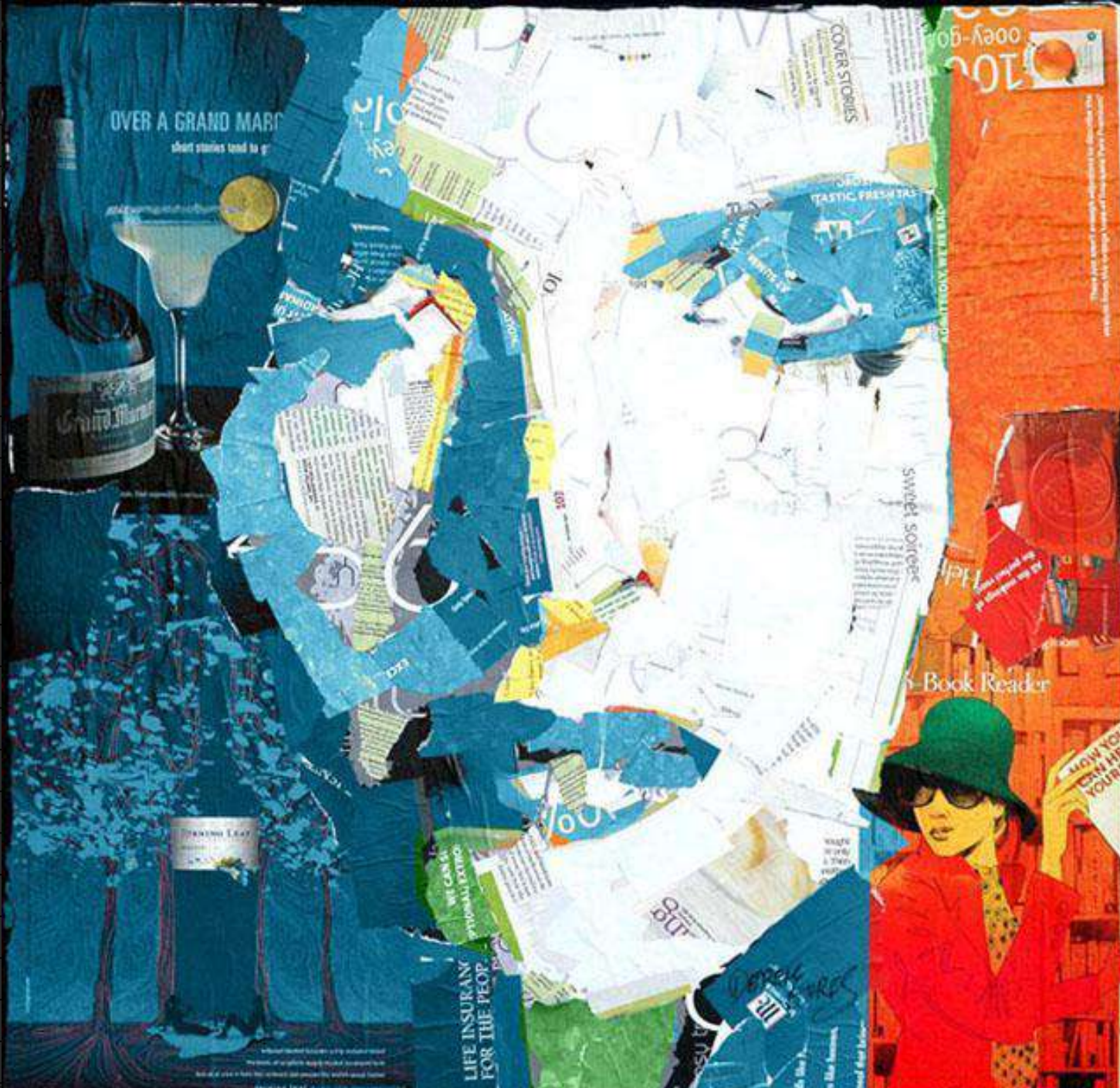

- 0 School appropriate





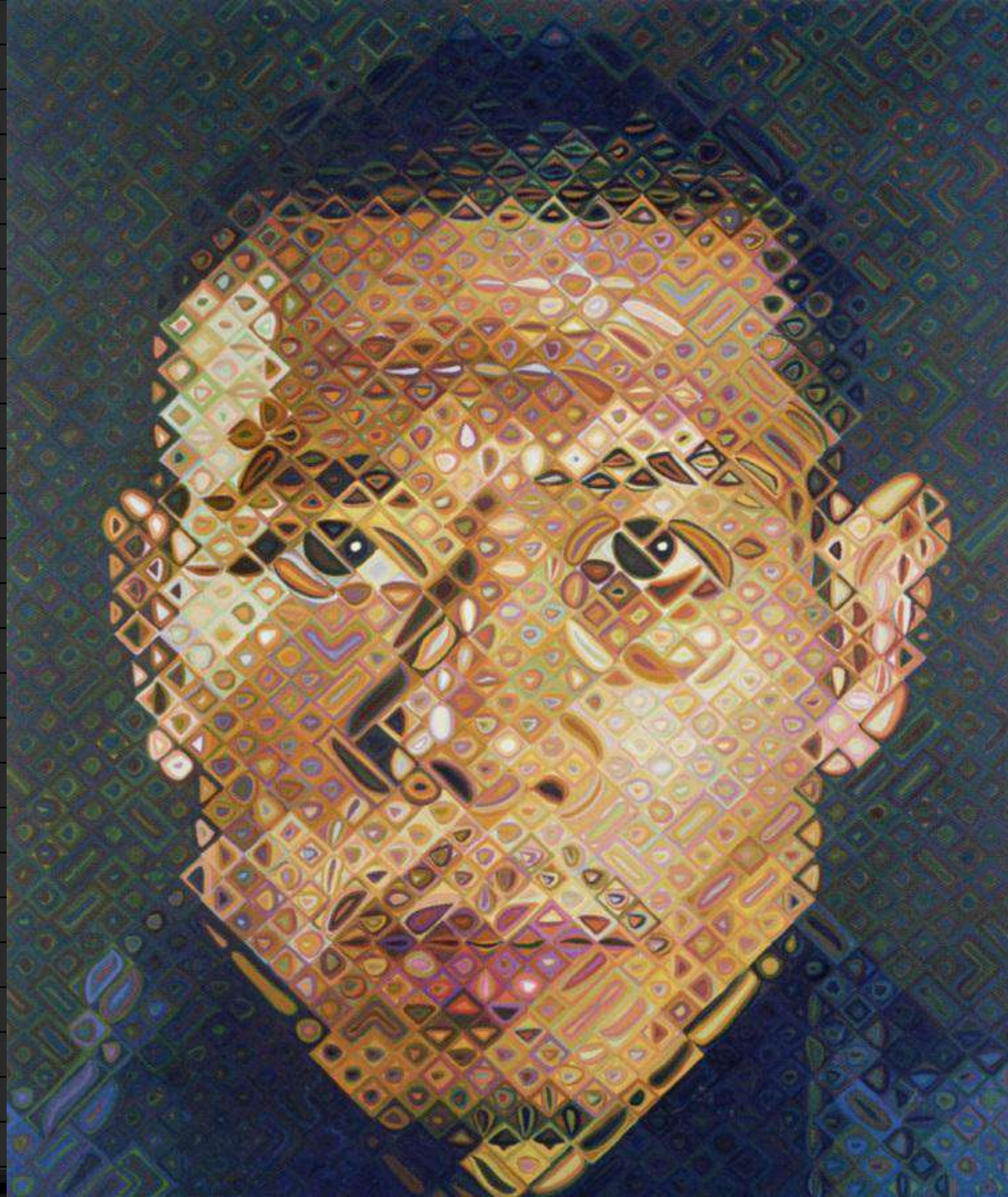




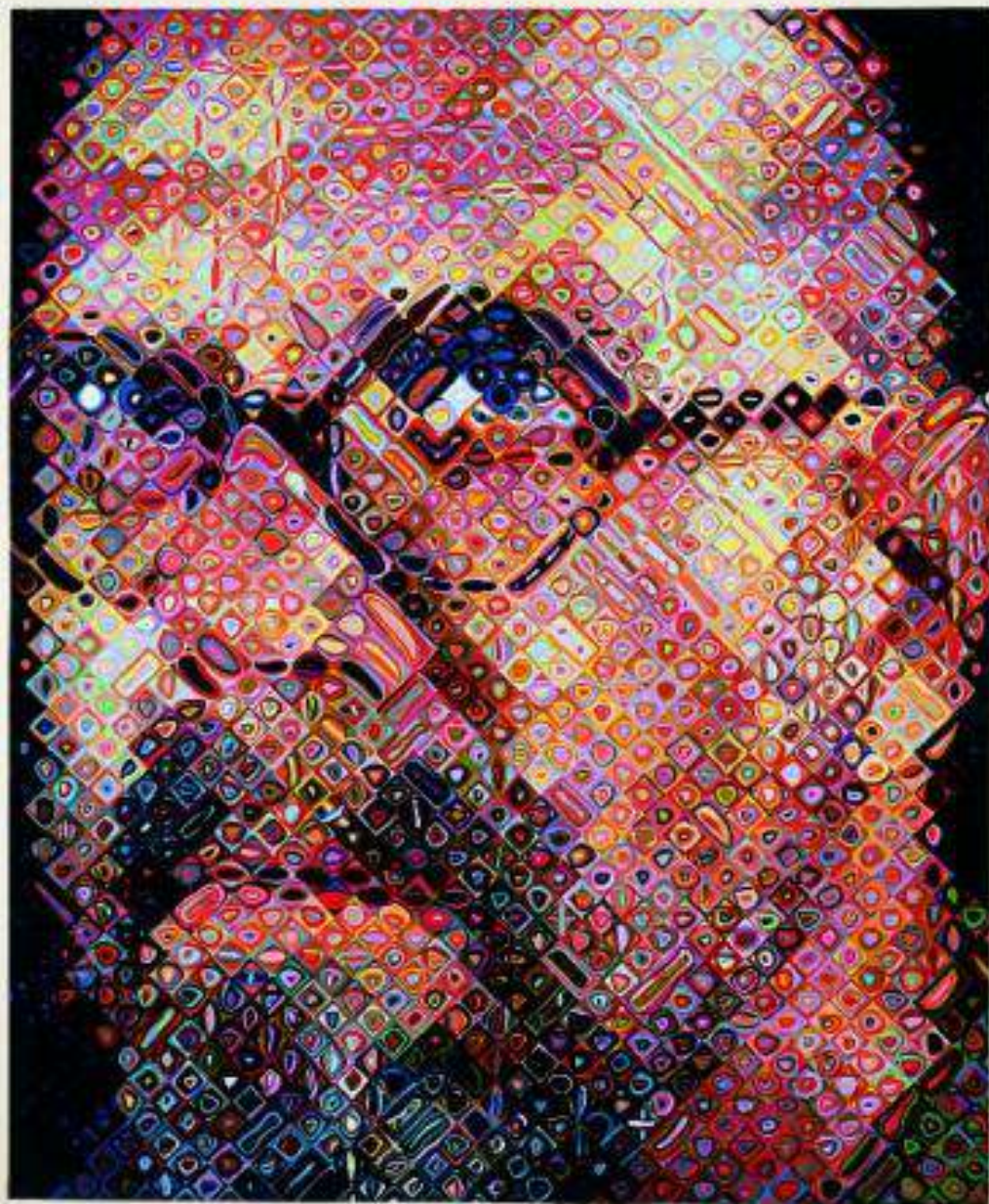
















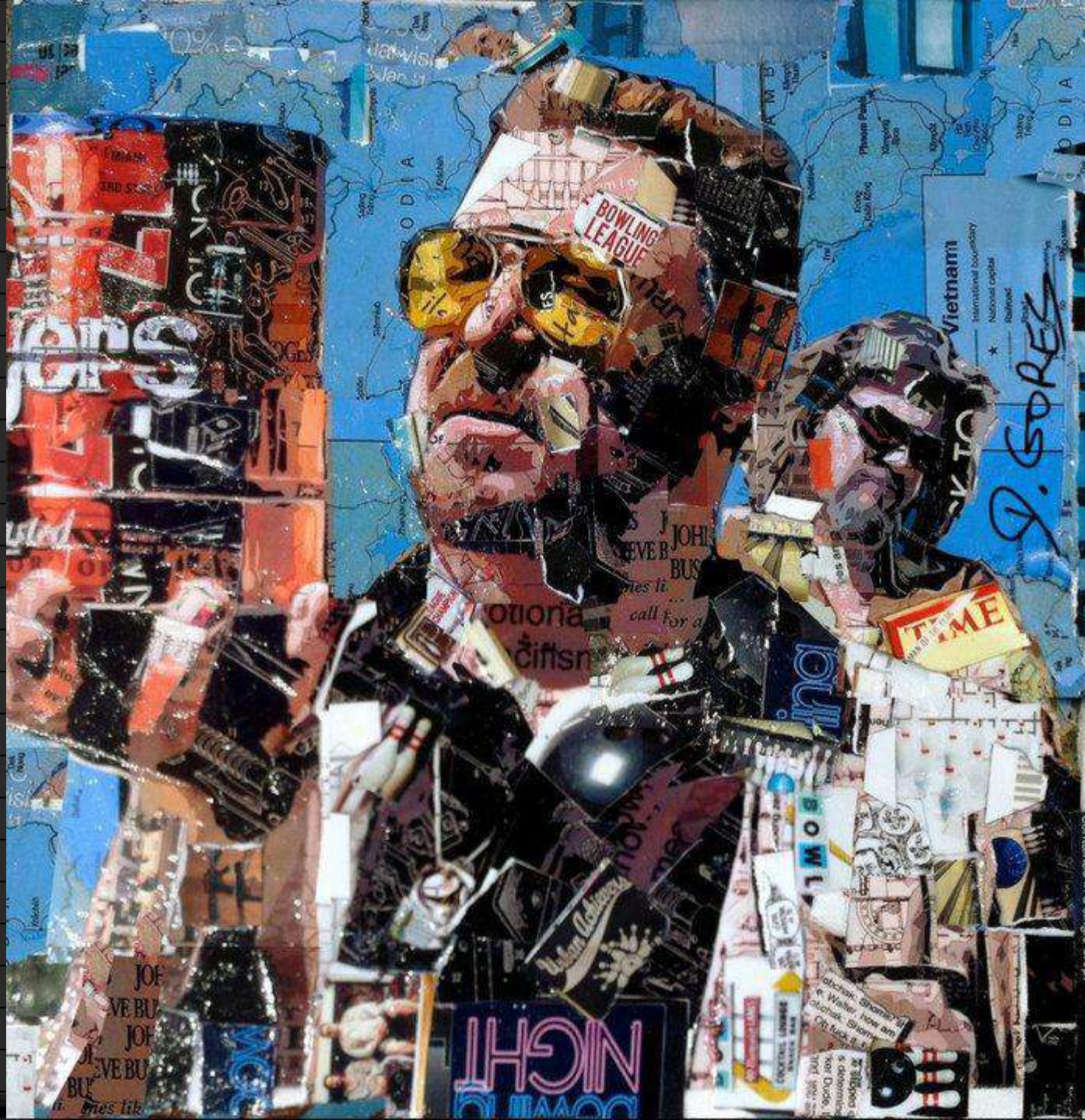

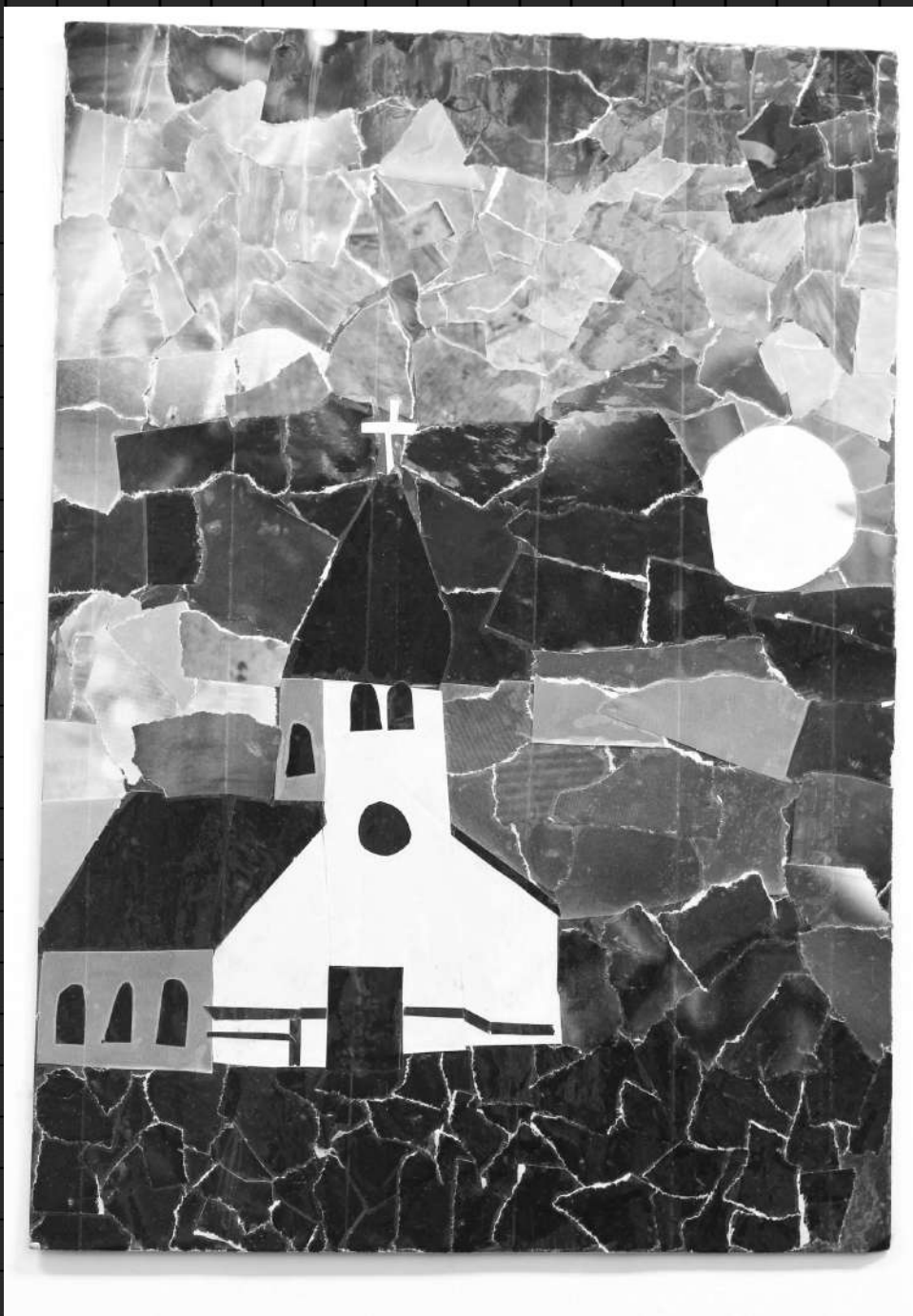














- Will you work alone? ½ sheet
