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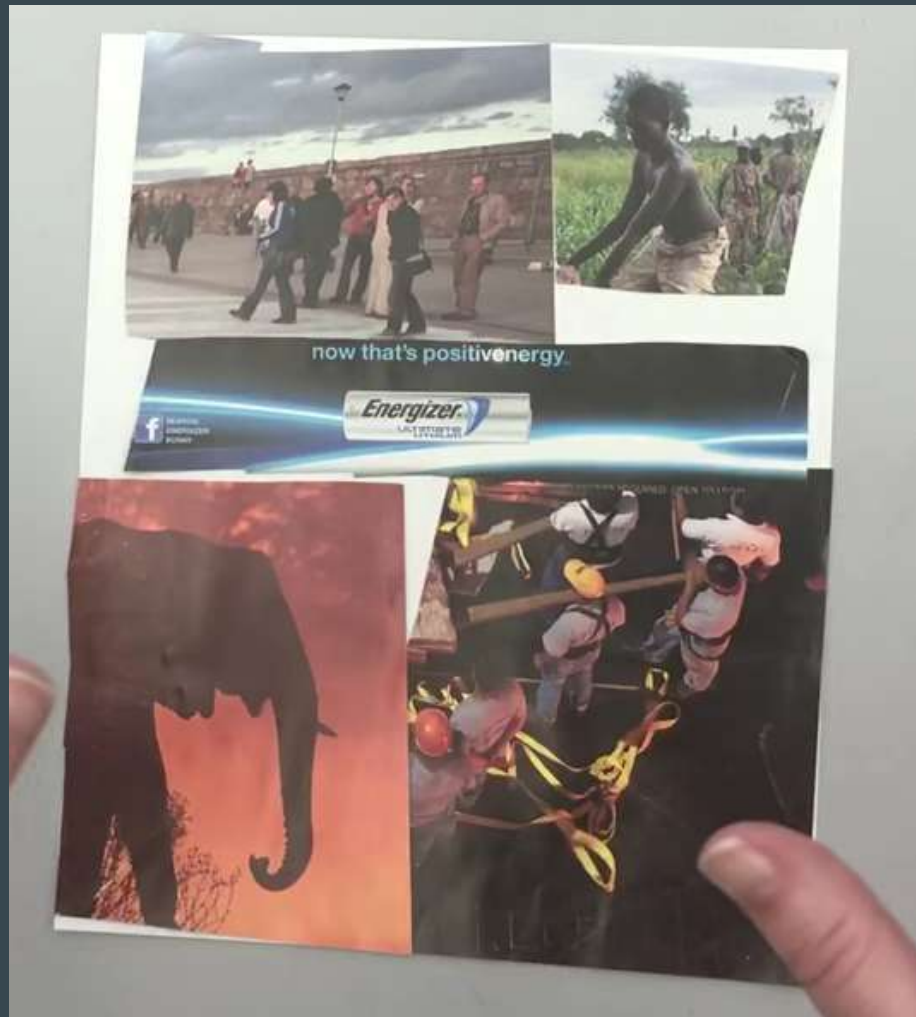
What to do and what to avoid

TERRIBLE!

-big boxy squares

-no background

-no interaction



SLIGHTLY BETTER

-cutting is a little better

-but still random

-still no background

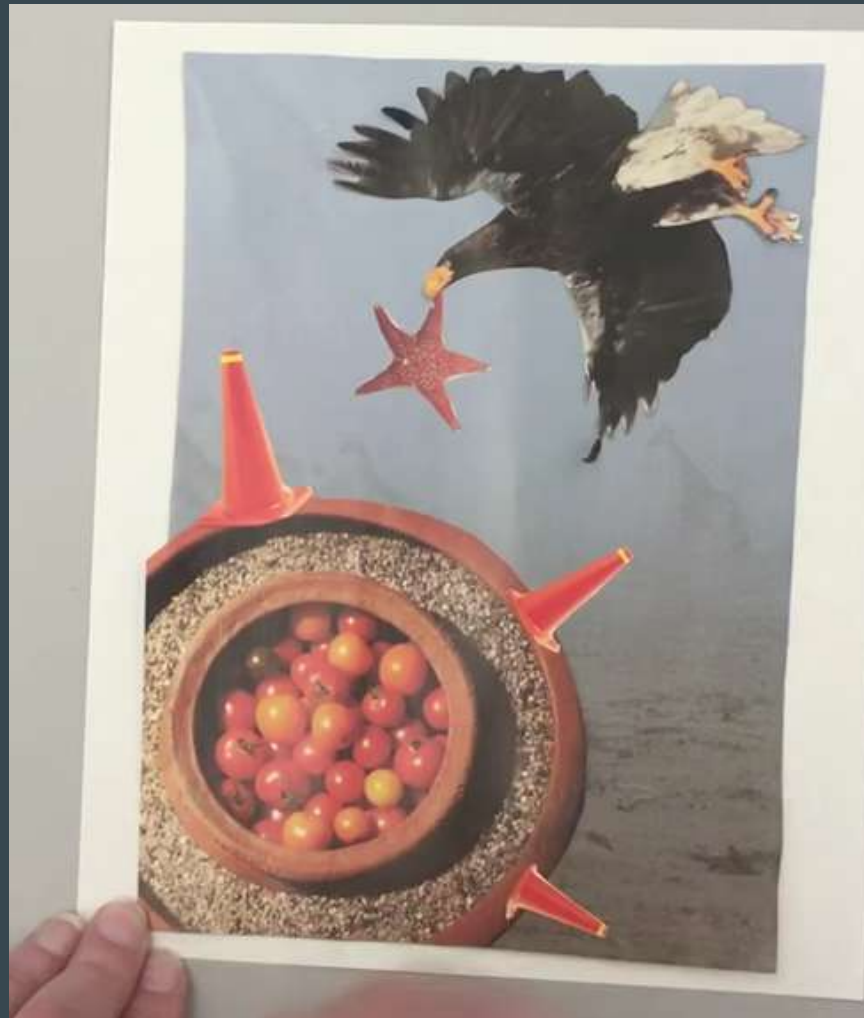


MUCH BETTER

-carefully cut out

-interaction

- 1) Directional
- 2) Between elements



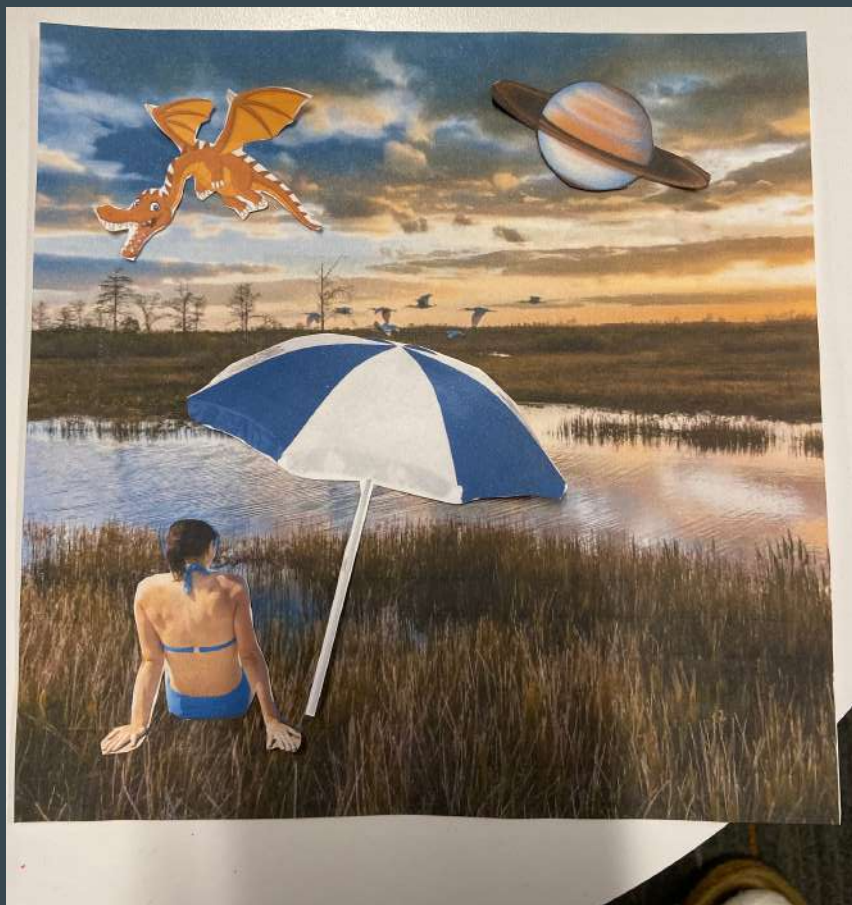
Even better

-works spatially, things stand/rest on parts of the background

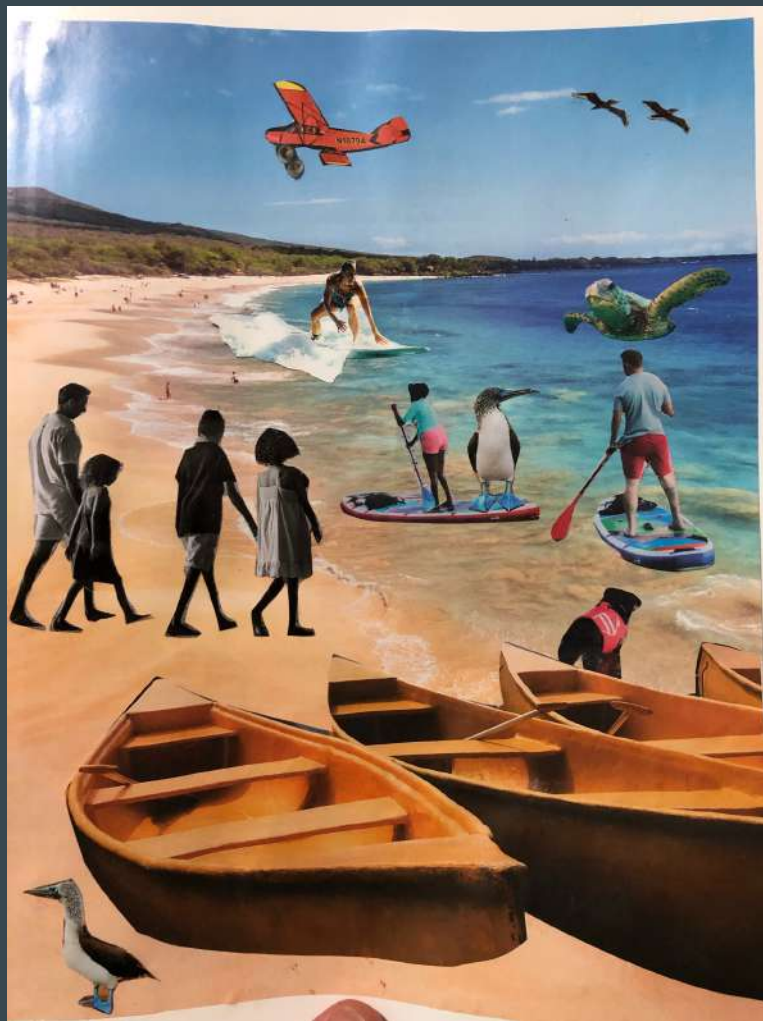
-tells a story, not just random



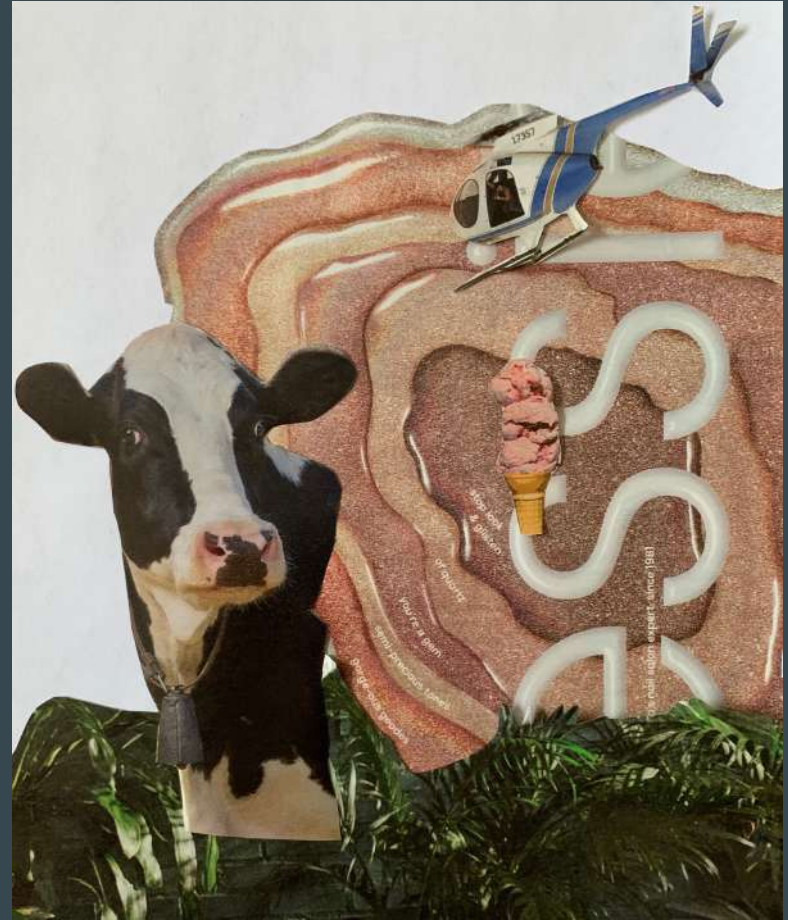








What is wrong with these?





Best Practices

- 1) Cut carefully
- 2) Start with background
- 3) Have objects interacting with the background
- 4) Have objects interact with each other
- 5) Don't have objects floating in space for no reason
- 6) Have a background and at least 4 other things
