	Submit SAT/ACT scores through the CollegeBoard or ACT website Remember, your counselor does not send your test scores; you do! Take a peek at the Fairtest.org website for a complete list of test-optional schools.
	Register as a student athlete with NCAA (future collegiate athletes only) If you are not hoping to play D1, D2, or D3 level athletics you do not need to worry about registering. This does not apply to intramurals or club level.
