



GOOGLE DRAWING COLOR SELF-PORTRAIT

Day 1: Students participate in the interactive Elements & Principles Pear Deck Presentation

Days 2-4: Teacher performs knowledge check on the elements & principles (I created a Canvas Quiz but you could do a Kahoot or something interactive to check that they understand!)

Days 2-4 Cont: Students engage in What is Digital Art Edpuzzle and watch the Google Drawings Practice Demo. Students begin practicing in Google Drawings using a simple photograph found through search in Google Drawings. Show various photographs of people representing quality vs. poor quality.

Day 5: Students take the color personality test to determine their color. Students watch a demo on Google Drawing Color Self-Portraits and begin working on their self-portrait. (For in-person, you should have students save a photograph of themselves prior to this.)

Day 6-7: Students continue working and then share their progress by downloading their Google Drawing as a PNG and then uploading to a Padlet board. Students provide feedback to at least 2 peers using the compliment sandwich model.

Day 8: Final project submission and process reflection. Students upload their work (as A PNG) to a Padlet, grade themselves using the rubric and complete a process reflection.
