

Vocabulary:

PRIMARY COLORS: THE THREE COLORS IN WHICH ALL OTHER COLORS ARE MADE (red, blue, and yellow)

SECONDARY: COLORS THE COMBINATION OF ANY TWO PRIMARY COLORS (orange, green, and violet)

COMPLEMENTARY: THE COLORS ACROSS FROM EACH OTHER ON THE COLOR WHEEL (red and green, blue and orange, and yellow and violet)

ANALOGOUS COLORS: THE COLORS CLOSELY RELATED TO ONE ANOTHER ON THE COLOR WHEEL

TERTIARY: THE COMBINATION OF A PRIMARY AND SECONDARY COLOR

MONOCHROMATIC: THE TINTS AND SHADES OF ONE HUE (A COLOR)

HUE: THE NAME OF THE COLOR

VALUE: THE RELATIVE DEGREE OF LIGHTNESS AND DARKNESS

TINT OF A COLOR: ADDING WHITE TO A HUE

SHADE OF A COLOR: ADDING BLACK TO A HUE

WARM COLOR: RED, ORANGE AND YELLOW

COOL COLORS: BLUE, GREEN AND PURPLE

TRIAD: THE COLORS ON THE COLOR WHEEL THAT FORM A TRIANGLE.

RED, YELLOW, AND BLUE

GREEN, VIOLET, AND ORANGE

RED-ORANGE, BLUE-VIOLET, AND YELLOW-GREEN
