FREE PRESCHOOL SCREENING

Preschool Screening is an opportunity for you to find out how your child is progressing in his/her development. It is also a chance for you to determine how your child's school readiness is moving forward.

Preschool Screening is for all children who will be 3 or 4 years old by September 1, 2017. Please schedule your child's appointment in your resident school district.

A **common myth** is that preschool screening is only for children needing or eligible for special programs such as Head Start, Great Start Readiness Program, or Early Childhood Special Education programs. This is **not** the case...your local school district encourages **all** children 3 or 4 years of age on or before September 1, 2017 to take advantage of this opportunity to learn more about your child's development!!


