### Below are changes to the 2017 resale:

- **One day sale – October 21<sup>st</sup>**

9 a.m. – 12 p.m. : All items at normal price

12 – 1 p.m. : Sale floor is closed to prepare for the half price sale

1 – 4 p.m. : All BLUE or WHITE tagged items are half price.

All YELLOW tags are at normal price.

- **Consignment Sellers**

Any seller who is unable to volunteer will be considered a "consignment seller" and your profit will be at 50%.

All other sellers must volunteer at least 2 hours (with one hour after 5 p.m. on October 21<sup>st</sup>) to receive your full 70% profit.

- **Clothing Pick-up**

All items that are not BLUE tagged, **MUST BE PICKED UP** between 6:30 – 7:30 p.m. on Saturday, October 21<sup>st</sup>

- **Donated Items**

All BLUE tagged items will be donated to local agencies and free stores that will not resell the items for profit. We are no longer offering the "SHOP FOR FREE" portion of the sale due to low attendance in the past years.

- **Check Pick-Up – October 24<sup>th</sup>**

Checks will be ready and can be picked up in the Lakeview School office between 1-4 p.m. on Tuesday, October 24<sup>th</sup>.
