

Lead the Way is a \$5,000 creative scholarship program sponsored by Community Blood Center and Vectren to support and encourage young adults who will be our blood resource leaders of tomorrow. CBC and Vectren will award \$1,000 in college tuition assistance to five graduating, college-bound seniors whose high school hosts a CBC blood drive.



Before you can LEAD... FOLLOW these directions:

- IMAGINE yourself a leader of your high school blood drive.
- Think of an original, effective **THEME** for your blood drive.
- STATE the theme with an appealing, clever and concise campaign SLOGAN.
- EXPLAIN the theme in a short statement that answers the question "Why do you believe your theme
 will encourage and inspire your classmates to donate blood?" (The answer should be brief and concise,
 explainable in two or three paragraphs, approximately 200 words).
- EXPRESS the theme in an original, artistic and creative fashion. You may choose conventional marketing/ recruitment tools (t-shirt, poster, brochures or video) or experiment with new concepts. Ingenuity is encouraged! The expression MUST BE USEFUL in promoting awareness of a high school blood drive and encouraging participation.
- SUBMIT your entire application packet by the April 20, 2015 deadline.

To be eligible to apply:

- 1. You must be a high school senior in the 2014-2015 academic year.
- 2. You must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- You must submit a letter of recommendation from your school blood drive faculty coordinator, a teacher or your school principal.

NOTE: You are NOT required to be a blood donor.

Your application packet must include:

- Your completed application form. (List of accomplishments may be submitted in a separate document.
- 2. An official copy of your high school transcript, including your senior year fall semester grades.
- 3. Your letter of recommendation.
- 4. Your campaign slogan.
- 5. A short explanation of your campaign theme and why it will be effective.
- The artistic expression of the theme. (Drawings and other renderings can be by hand or computer generated. Videos should be submitted on DVD).

Selection Process:

- CBC and Vectren select committees to judge all entries and choose the scholarship winners.
- Scholarship winners will be notified in May, 2015.
- CBC/CTS employees and their families are not eligible to participate.
