HOW MANY CHEMICAL COMPOUNDS CAN YOU FIND IN YOUR HOME?

Everything around us is matter, and all matter is made of particles called **atoms** and **molecules**. When different kinds of atoms join together they make **COMPOUNDS**.

Lots of compounds can be found in everyday products. For example, sodium chloride (NaCl) is a compound that's also called **salt**. By reading labels, you can find many different compounds.

Read the labels on foods, cleaning products, cosmetics, medicines, and personal care products (like deodorant, shampoo, and toothpaste). Look for any element names you find.
