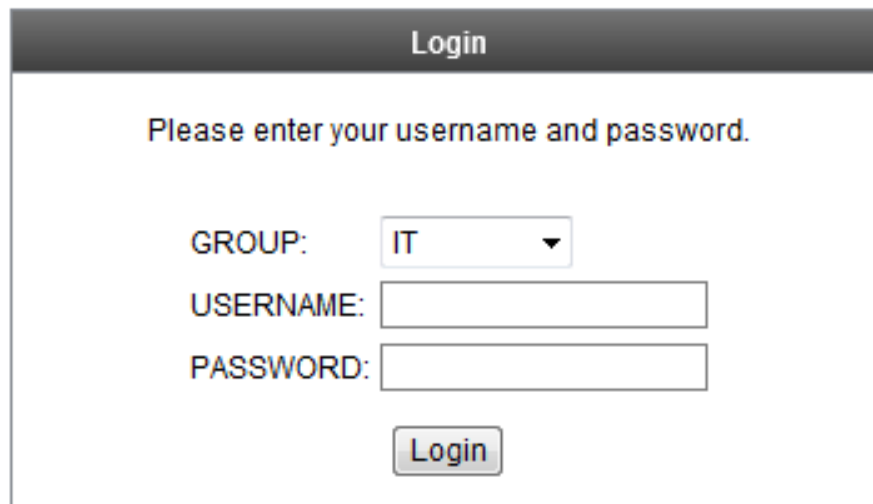


Connecting to the Paterson Network using VPN

Open your browser such as Internet Explorer or Safari and type in the following address:

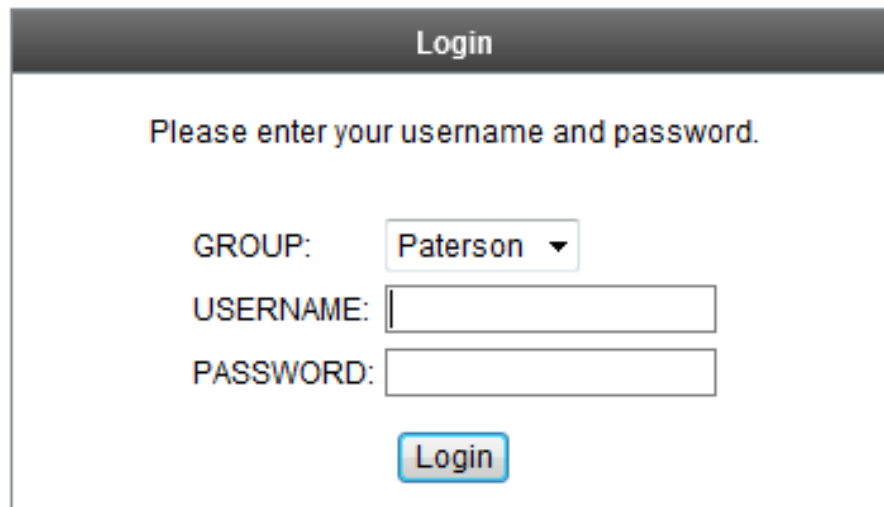
<https://webvpn.paterson.k12.nj.us>

Click on the down arrow besides IT and select Paterson.
