CONTOUR LINE DRAWING

- 1. Arrange 3 to 5 still-life objects in the center of the table. Be sure that they overlap to help show depth or distance.
- 2. On 9x12 manila paper, draw out the shapes. Use strong solid lines not sketchy lines. (Remember: a contour line is a line that represents an outline of the subject/object).
- 3. Think about the proportions: the comparison of elements one to another in terms of size.
- 4. Accurately draw the shapes, the placement, and the size of the objects.
- 5. Balance the positive and negative space.
