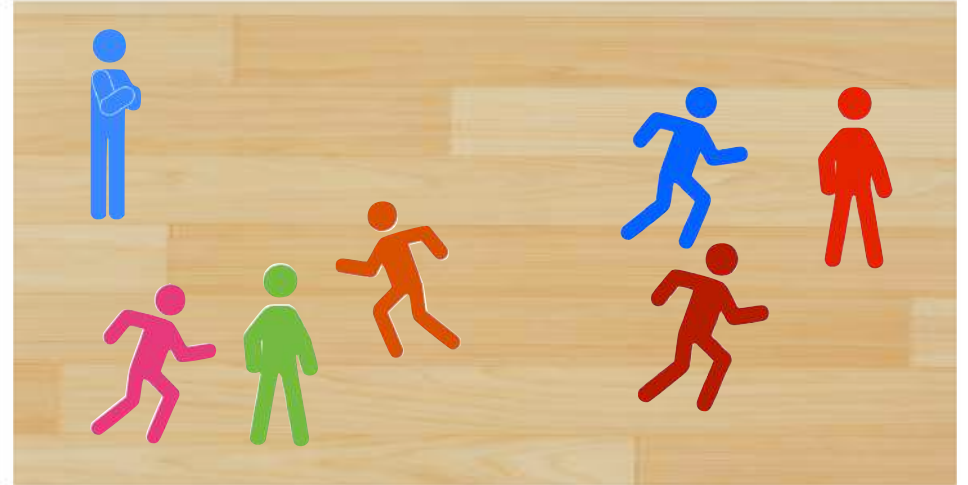


Rules of Play

- Cone out the playing area and have students run around the playing area in different directions slowly building up speed
- Shout out a number (ex: five) and then the students have to find a group of five and sit down as soon as possible
- Make the game more exciting by counting down the seconds they have left and then shouting 3-2-1 stop!
- Any students who can't find a group perform a fun challenge (ex: writing their name in the air with their bum or doing a silly touchdown dance - do not have them do sit-ups or push-ups as a challenge)
- When each new round starts make sure that students are running around on their own in different locations as to avoid forming groups of the same students each time

Variations and Progressions

- Students are given a point each time they get into a group in the specified time. Play for a set period of time and the player with the most points at the end wins the game
