





A Review of Google Classroom for Students and Parents


Student credentials are required to access a classroom, or you can have your student show you from their Chromebook device.




Log onto Your Internet Browser and Type in Google Classroom




After clicking on Classroom and logging in with your school google account, you will see this page which shows all of the classes the student is enrolled in.




If you click on to-do...




you can see all future assignments that your class instructor has posted.




If you click on calendar...



You can see all assignments due in a calendar format




When you click on each class...




It will take you to a page like this that shows a stream of all the announcement, assignments, and quizzes that your teacher has posted in chronological order.




When clicking on the options bar in the top left...

Allows you to see all assignments posted for only the class you are viewing.








Google Classroom for Parents and Guardians




Guardians can also receive reports from google classroom courtesy of an invite from their students' teachers.


*To activate this functionality, please contact the students teacher to be added.
