Photography Assignment NAME_

Photos due at the beginning of class Wednesday, September 29 in folder and presentation so that we can view them. You will have class time Tuesday Sept. 28 to take photos in class and upload photos from both inside and outside of class, but if you do this beforehand you may use the time for other work.

Your photos will be of reflections or reflected images. Images may include the use of mirrors, reflections from surfaces or objects such as sunglasses, car bumpers, or a spoon, or reflections in a body of water such as a lake, river, or birdbath. These are only suggestions-find some creative ideas of your own.

"Reflections" consists of a minimum of 30 photos taken, and 5 submitted in a Google presentation. Keep in mind that these 30 do not have to be vastly different. A good photographer will take multiple shots of the same scene in order to choose the best one. **You may** <u>not</u> use the same photo for different assignments. All photos submitted must be new. You are encouraged to take more than 30 photos.

KEEP your original pictures-NEVER edit the originals-COPY the images to transfer. Place the following in your shared folder:

Copies of 30 photos in a folder labeled with your "yourlastname:reflectionsoriginals"

A Google presentation "last name:reflections" with 5 selected photos and for grading. All submitted photos should be cropped to a 4 X 6 format with no other edits other than cropping.

If you have time, edit a COPY of the photo to place side by side with the original on a second slide for each photo. This may improve your grade.
