Wonders: primarily for phonemic awareness, reading skills and strategies, comprehension, and grammar skills.

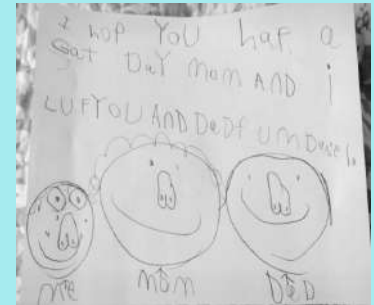
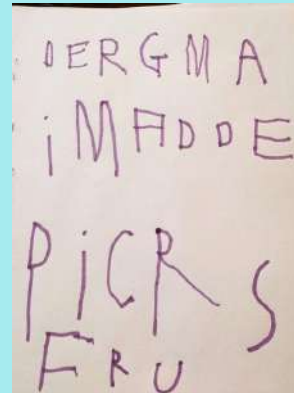
Foundations: primarily for phonemic awareness and proper letter formation

- Patterns
- Skip counting
- Composing and decomposing numbers

Science Program

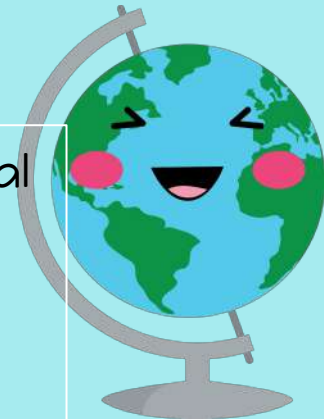
We use Elevate Science. It will cover:

We use HMH Impact Social Studies. It will cover:

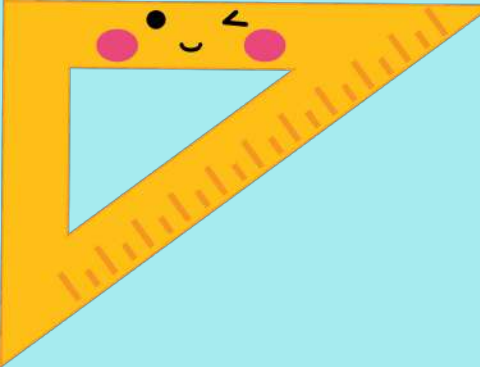
1. Good Citizens

3. Our Country



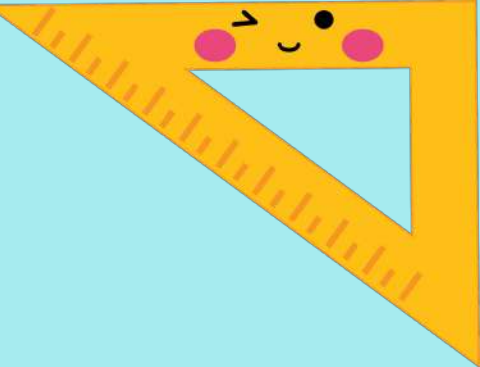
Updates and Upcoming Events

 6. Reminders of upcoming events



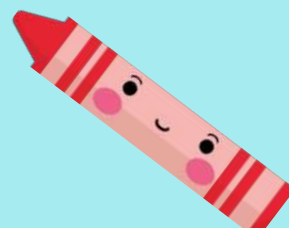


Report Card Grading Codes

Never too early for a cookie.

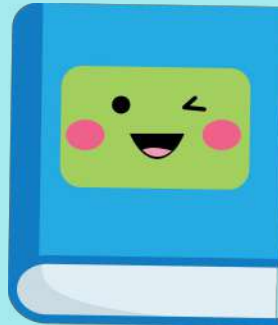


Lunch:
