Our Community

Corbett School District is located in unincorporated Corbett, Oregon, just 22 miles from downtown Portland, Oregon and at the mouth of the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area. Corbett offers the best of both worlds: the sense of community and quality of life that are part of small-town living as well as access to a culturally vibrant, metropolitan city.

Our School

Corbett High School has been recognized as one of the highest performing schools in the country by The Washington Post, Newsweek, and US News and World Reports. Students are challenged by a prolific Advanced Placement for All program; a program that also produces one of the highest graduation rates in the state.

Corbett High School moved to an eight period A-B block schedule in 21-22. Juniors and Seniors can elect to take part in a Middle College program, where they take classes at Corbett and at Mt. Hood Community College. Juniors and Seniors also have access to a work-study or internship program.

Extensive student activity programs include athletics, drama, music, philanthropy, and student leadership.

Corbett School District believes in multi-age instruction, as well as co-seating students who are AP level and high school level in the same course so that every student has access to high-quality, rigorous instruction.

Each grade level has between 75 and 110 students. The K-12 district supports approximately 1200 students.

Grading System

Students receive letter grades based on their achievement in each class. A letter grade is based on the teacher's professional evaluation of student achievement and master of course content.

Grade point average is determined using a four-point system for non-weighted, a five point system for weighted. Both averages will be reported on student transcripts. A "P" for a class may be awarded to indicate that a student has passed the course, which is not factored in the GPA. An "I" indicates that a student has not completed enough satisfactory work to pass the class. We do not rank students.

COVID-19: All Oregon schools were closed from March 16th, 2020, through the end of the school year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. During this time, instruction was delivered per the Oregon Department of Education's "Distance Learning for All" guidance, and pass/incomplete grades were used for Trimester 3 of 2020. During the 20-21 school year, all students participated in comprehensive distance learning via Zoom. Corbett High School used a 3 period schedule for 6 weeks with 6 classes per trimester, which were graded both A-I and pass/incomplete.
