Human Services Cluster



The Cosmetology program is designed to prepare students to qualify for the licensing examination. Cosmetology students receive training in the art and science of the care and beautification of hair, skin, and nails. The course includes scalp treatments, hair shaping, hair styling, setting, waving, hair coloring, and shampoos and rinses. Instruction in chemistry, bacteriology, and anatomy and physiology of the face, head, arms, and hands is incorporated by means of theory and practical application on both mannequins and live models. Also included in the course of study is salon planning and management.

Only 20 students per year are accepted into the program per LLR requirements. The required kit of supplies needed for completion of the program must be purchased by each Cosmetology student at the beginning of the 11th grade year. Prices will vary each year. Approximate cost of kit is \$400. Also, the cost to take the state board exam is \$175.

Program Duration & Grade Level

Cosmetology is a two (2) year program. Grade levels: 11 and 12 Level 1: AM session

Requirements for Certifications

Students must meet all of the following requirements set forth by the SC Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation:

- <u>LLR requires a valid Social Security Card and Driver's License/State Issued ID in</u> order to receive a SC Cosmetology Licensure
- Be at least 16 years old
- 10th Grade Completion
- Successfully complete 1540 hours approved by SC Dept. of LLR
- Pay the exam fee- \$175.00
- Submit an application to LLR
- Pass the NIC (National-Interstate Council of State Boards to Cosmetology) Written and Practical Exam
