Pre - ACT - 10th grade

The Pre-ACT will be given to all 10th graders on October 5th. This is a practice test for the ACT college admissions test. The test consists of 4 timed sections – English, Reading, Math, and Science. Students will be able to get a feel for what the ACT will be like. From the scores students will see what their current knowledge and skills are. They will be able to see what areas they need to improve on before taking the actual ACT in 11th grade.

PSAT/NMSQT - 11th grade

The PSAT/NMSQT will be given to all 11th graders on October 19th. This a practice test for the SAT. It is also linked to the National Merit Scholarship program when taken in 11th grade. The test consist of reading, writing and math components. Juniors received an information book with practice questions.

Students should try their best on these practice tests as the results will help students to see what areas they may need to improve on before taking the actual ACT and SAT tests.
