Venture Communications Community Service Scholarship

Venture Communications will be offering 14 - \$750 Scholarships to 2025 graduating seniors in their service area.

To be eligible:

- The students' parents or legal guardian must be an active subscriber of Venture Communications.
- Students must have a cumulative B average.
- The scholarships are awarded based on Community Service, Academics, School Involvement, and Essay.

The Scholarships will be awarded prior to the start of the second semester of the 1st year students are enrolled in a post-secondary school.

Applications must be submitted **ONLINE**.

Deadline: March 7

BBB Scholarship Program

The BBB Student of Integrity Scholarship Program honors students who demonstrate outstanding leadership and integrity. These awards are made possible by the BBB Education Foundation.

BBB Midwest Plains provides three \$2,000 scholarships for each of the five regions in its service area: Kansas City & Western Missouri, Kansas Plains, Lincoln & Greater Nebraska, Omaha & Southwest Iowa, and South Dakota.

South Dakota Farm Bureau Scholarship

SD Farm Bureau is dedicated to agriculture in our state. This scholarship is to celebrate youth that have a passion for agriculture and their rural communities. We want to award scholarships to youth who are planning on returning to rural communities to work. Applicants can choose to be considered for an agriculture-focus or community-focus scholarship, depending on their major and/or experience with agriculture.

Eligibility Guidelines:

1. Applicant, applicant's parents or guardians must be a current member of South Dakota Farm Bureau and must have been a member for 2 years.
2. Not allowed to receive this scholarship award more than once.
3. Must be accepted by an accredited school of higher learning and planning to study a minimum of one year as a full-time student.
4. Must be 17 years of age or older, a high school graduate or a college freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior. If still in high school, must have an expected graduation date of Spring 2025.
5. Applications from high school seniors must include a copy of most recent ACT score or Accuplacer score. All applicants must include current transcript with grade point average.
6. Graduate students are not eligible for this scholarship.
7. Scholarship is applied toward tuition fees only and will be awarded after the first semester.

South Dakota Community Foundation Scholarships

NOW an application portal!

- Step 1: register your account as “Individual”
 - Do NOT use your k-12 email!
- Step 2: Receive confirmation message and click “View” to start the process of applying
 - PHASE 1: Common Application Phase – provide complete and truthful answers
 - On final page of Phase 1 “Scholarship Information” you will see a list of scholarships based solely on your selected HS
 - Click SUBMIT
 - PHASE 2: in GOapply, you will see an empty checklist of scholarships based on selected High School as well as statewide opportunities.
 - You will need to check “YES” in the opt in section to show statewide scholarship descriptions
 - Finalize your selections; click “Next” to begin the application process. The system will guide you through the process.

Scholarships previously available in-office but now are using the GOapply portal:

- **Curtis Marvin Hohn Scholarship** – DUE: MARCH 10
 - awarded to seniors graduation from a SD high school attending a public or private college/university or technical school in South Dakota. (Preference will be given to applicants pursuing studies in history, political science, or water resources). Applicants should reflect the values that embodied Curtis Hohn’s life: integrity, individual character, courage; leadership in school and community; involvement in civic affairs; participation in organizations that shape the school and community; leadership to reform policies that benefit school and community; work ethic; interest in national and global issues; interest in humanitarian issues.
- **Oahe Racers Association Scholarship** – DUE: MARCH 31
 - must be graduating for a SD high school; Planning to pursue a degree in Automotive; attending one of the four TECHNICAL COLLEGES in South Dakota
- **Inez Taylor Walter Scholarship** – DUE: APRIL 1
 - Preference given to a student planning on attending a South Dakota or North Dakota college in the field of nursing
- **Dr. Dale A. Gibson Oral Health Scholarship** – DUE: APRIL 15
 - Must be pursuing a Dental Assisting degree at Lake Area Technical College; Intend to remain in SD after graduating from LATC; must have strong academic qualifications; first preference goes to candidates from South Dakota; second preference to those with a greater financial need
- **Esther Edie Environmental Scholarship** – DUE: APRIL 15
 - Awarded to a student in their Final year of schooling; must be attending a SD college or university; must be pursuing a degree in Environmental Science (biology or chemistry), Environmental Geography, Environmental Sociology, Natural Resource Management or Environmental Law
- **Gene Abdallah Scholarship** – DUE: APRIL 15
 - Must graduate from a South Dakota High School; cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher; Must be pursuing a career in Law Enforcement; Include a letter of acceptance from a SD college/university or vocational school which applicant plans to attend; submit a short essay.
