GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS AUDIT

Use the “Grad Reqs” tab (on the left side of your Skyward screen) to see what credits you still need in order to graduate. Courses you are currently taking are marked as “In Progress” and will count for credit once passed (in June).

Note: If you take more courses than are required for a certain subject, the extras count as “General Electives.”

Notes about selecting courses:

- You may see other courses from previous years (like Algebra and Biology) but you cannot retake these if you already received that credit. The only courses that can be retaken are: Choir, Band, Science Research, Advance PE and Weightlifting.
- Advanced courses have pre-requisites you need to pass first. Skyward will not allow you to request courses for which you have not taken pre-reqs. If you are currently taking the pre-req course, make sure you pass or you will be removed from next year's advanced class.

Required courses already requested on your behalf:

- English 11
- US History (Note: LET US KNOW IF YOU WANT TO TAKE AP US HISTORY)
- Algebra II or Honors Precal/Trig

Steps for requesting courses:

1. Log into Skyward
2. In the menu on the left side, click “Schedule.”
3. In the upper right corner, click “Request Courses for 2020-2021.”
4. Look through the options and mouse-over for descriptions. To request a course, click on it and use the “Add Course” button in the middle of the screen. The course will then move to the right-hand column.
5. Keep choosing until the upper right corner says “Total Credits 14.000”
6. At the top, click “Request Alternates” and choose 4 credits of course alternates in case your requests are full.
7. Everything is saved in real time; there is no save button.
