  not be scheduled for grade 9 History but should consider selecting History electives. Families are encouraged to discuss this recommendation with the
  Supervisor of Social Studies.
- \*\*\* Spanish STAIRS (#202, #203) is a two year sequence for students who require additional support in the study of World Language.
- \*\*\*\* Students selecting Spanish for Heritage Speakers will be contacted about prerequisite placement exam dates.
- Students will be able to select sports that are of interest. The list of sports will be located in the "ZATH" subject area field during on-line scheduling. Selecting a sport will not automatically enroll students in the activity.

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
