CMS COVID-19 Grading Guidelines

(NCDPI EOY Grading and Promotion FAQ)

Elementary (K-5)

- No final grades will be given to students.
- Teachers will provide feedback on individual student strengths and needs from both an academic and social/emotional perspective to ensure an effective transition from the spring 2020 remote learning process to the 2020-21 school year.
- In order to prepare for next year, assignments and activities will continue to be provided and are encouraged to be completed.
- All students will receive a CMS End-of-Year Feedback form.

Middle (6-8)

- Student remote learning work is being assessed by teachers and used to determine improvement and progress. A written feedback form will be sent to parents at the end of the school year.

 Student remote learning work is being assessed by teachers and used to be sent to parents at the end of the school year.
- Students receive PC19 (Pass) or WC19 (Withdrawal) based on performance.
- For Semester 2 high school courses for credit (4x4 and yearlong), there is a choice of PC19, WC19, or a final numeric grade.
- Final grades will not count toward the Grade Point Average (GPA).

High (9-11)

(plus rising grade 13 & middle school students taking high school courses for credit)

- Semester 1 grades for all courses (4x4 or yearlong) will remain intact and count in the GPA.
- Students will have a choice for how their 2nd semester final grades are recorded on their transcript (4x4 and yearlong).
- Students will choose between a PC19 (Pass), WC19 (Withdraw) or their earned numeric grade for each Semester 2 course. For yearlong courses, if the final grade is higher than the Semester 1 grade, the higher grade will be recorded for both semesters.

Seniors

- Semester 1 grades for all courses (4x4 or year-long) will remain intact and count in the GPA.
- Students will receive a PC19 (Pass) or WC19 (Withdraw) based on their learning as of Quarter 3.
- If students had an 'F' as of Quarter 3 for graduation requirements, students will be given learning opportunities to improve to a passing grade throughout the remainder of the year.
