#### Greater Jasper Consolidated Schools COVID Online Academy (EdOptions) 2020-2021 School Year

- COVID Online Acadmey will be implemented through a partnership with Edmentum's EdOptions Academy.
  - The COVID Online Academy (EdOptions) is a rigorous curricular program. This Online Academy will <u>not</u> be structured or implemented as eLearning was in Spring 2020.
  - o EdOptions Academy provides certified teachers. *The teacher that your child will interact with is not a GJCS teacher; however, your student remains a GJCS student.*
  - o Students will interact with the content of the curriculum through a digital dashboard with live support available from 8:00am-5:00pm from EdOptions Academy certified teachers.
    - Students should plan to spend 3-5 hours for elementary or 5-6 hours for middle/high per day, on average, engaged with the curriculum.
    - No restrictions on when students must sign in and invest those hours; however, attendance will be taken based on appropriate weekly progress as defined by EdOptions Academy.
    - Students will engage with the curriculum in a completely virtual environment; younger students will need the support of a parent/other adult to navigate the system and serve as their learning guide.
    - Live help sessions available throughout the day. After hours support calls can be scheduled with the student's EdOptions Academy teacher.
  - o Grades K-1 students will be enrolled in ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies, PE and Health
  - o Grade 2-5 students will be enrolled in ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies, PE and Health, and Art and Picture Study
  - Grades 6-12 students will be enrolled in 6 courses that best align to their previously built schedule. Honors level courses are not available except for the Advanced Placement courses listed below.
  - Student will be provided a school-issued device.
- A GJCS facilitator will provide support in registration, progress monitoring, and technology troubleshooting of GJCS devices. The GJCS facilitator will not provide academic support; the student's EdOptions Academy teacher will provide any and all academic support that is needed.
- Final grades will be provided by EdOptions Academy and transferred to the student's GJCS transcript/permanent record.
- Students are expected to commit to a semester at a time if utilizing the Covid Online Academy. A drop period will be available until August 26, 2020.
  - o In the scenario that in-person GJCS students shift to eLearning, students who have opted for the Covid Online Academy will remain in the Covid Online Academy setting. They will not shift to GJCS teachers.
  - Outside of the two week drop period, Covid Online Academy students may opt to return to in-person instruction with GICS teachers only at the semester break.
- Student fees will align to the associated grade level or course fees for in-person instruction.
- Registration process:
  - o Complete GJCS registration ensuring all contact information is up to date.
  - When prompted, select the option to opt for the Covid Online Academy.
  - Your child will then be enrolled in the appropriate courses and you will be contacted by your EdOptions Academy teacher with start-up information.
