January 4, 2007, Craig lost his life in a plane accident.

Craig loved his Lord, family and community. He also had a passion for Special Olympics. He began volunteering with his Dad at the age of 9. The highway patrol was a very important part of his life as well. He spent every summer helping his dad with Cadet Lawman Academy, and also attended the camp the summer before his senior year.

As a result of many years of playing soccer and having mentors such as Coach Jimmy Hampton, he developed many attributes which he demonstrated both on and off the soccer field. Craig gave 100% in soccer and everything he did.
