Step 1: Preparing the Jar

Please use one of the two jar files I have provided. You can find them here:

Next: Open Photopea. www.photopea.com

Step 2: Layering on the Landscape

Your jar should now look like this:




Now, follow the second video to layer in your landscape, scaling the landscape, and applying the blending mode:

Step 3: Burning in the Landscape

Your jar and layers panel should now look like this:

- Very faint view of the landscape
- Two layers with an Overlay



Step 3 will walk you through how to burn the image into view and clean up the edges:
