

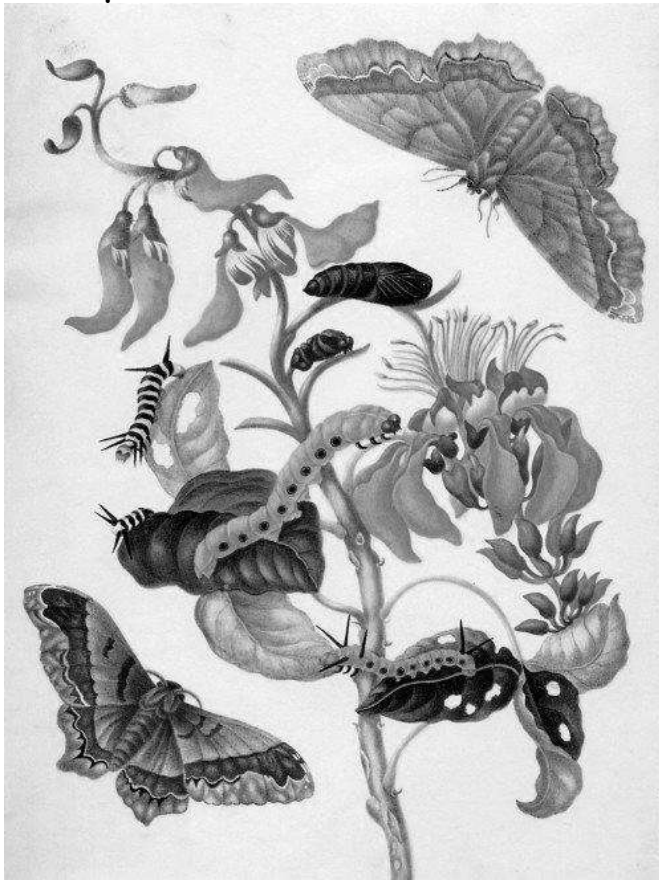
Many famous artists have been scientists.
