Physical Education	1.5 credits
Computer Science	1 credit
Drivers Education/First Aid	.5 credit
Health education	.5 credit
Required Classes	14.5 Credits
Elective Credits	9.5 credits
	24 credits

^{*} The state of Wisconsin requires that .5 credit of health education may be earned in grades 7-12

A school board may grant a diploma to a student who does not satisfy the credit requirements outlined in 118.33 (1)(d) if all of the following apply:

- 1. The student was enrolled in an approved alternative education program and
- 2. the school board determines that the student has demonstrated a level of proficiency in the subjects listed equivalent to that which he/she would have attained if he/she had satisfied the credit requirements.

Students graduating after September 1, 2003 shall be required to demonstrate writing proficiency based on assessment of the student's portfolio.
