

Refusal of Direct English Language Development Services

Parents can opt to not enroll their child in an EL program. If a parent decides to waive EL services, the school corporation should keep written documentation of that decision.

By signing below...

you understand the following:

- The student will still be tested until she/he reaches English proficiency (scores at a Level 5 on the spring annual English Proficiency test; and
- The student will have an Individualized Learning Plan (ILP) and will receive appropriate adaptations to classroom instruction and assessments based on the student's language level in order to ensure student's meaningful participation and learning in academic subject areas; and
- The student will receive appropriate accommodations for Limited English proficient (LEP) students of Levels 1-4 on all standardized testing.
- Parents have the right to opt back into EL services at any time.

you agree that the following procedures were followed:

- You contacted the school wishing to refuse direct services for the child; and
- A conversation/consultation about how language development program will benefit the student has occurred between the you and district staff, and the parent's concerns have been addressed; and
- You still refuse direct services for your child.
