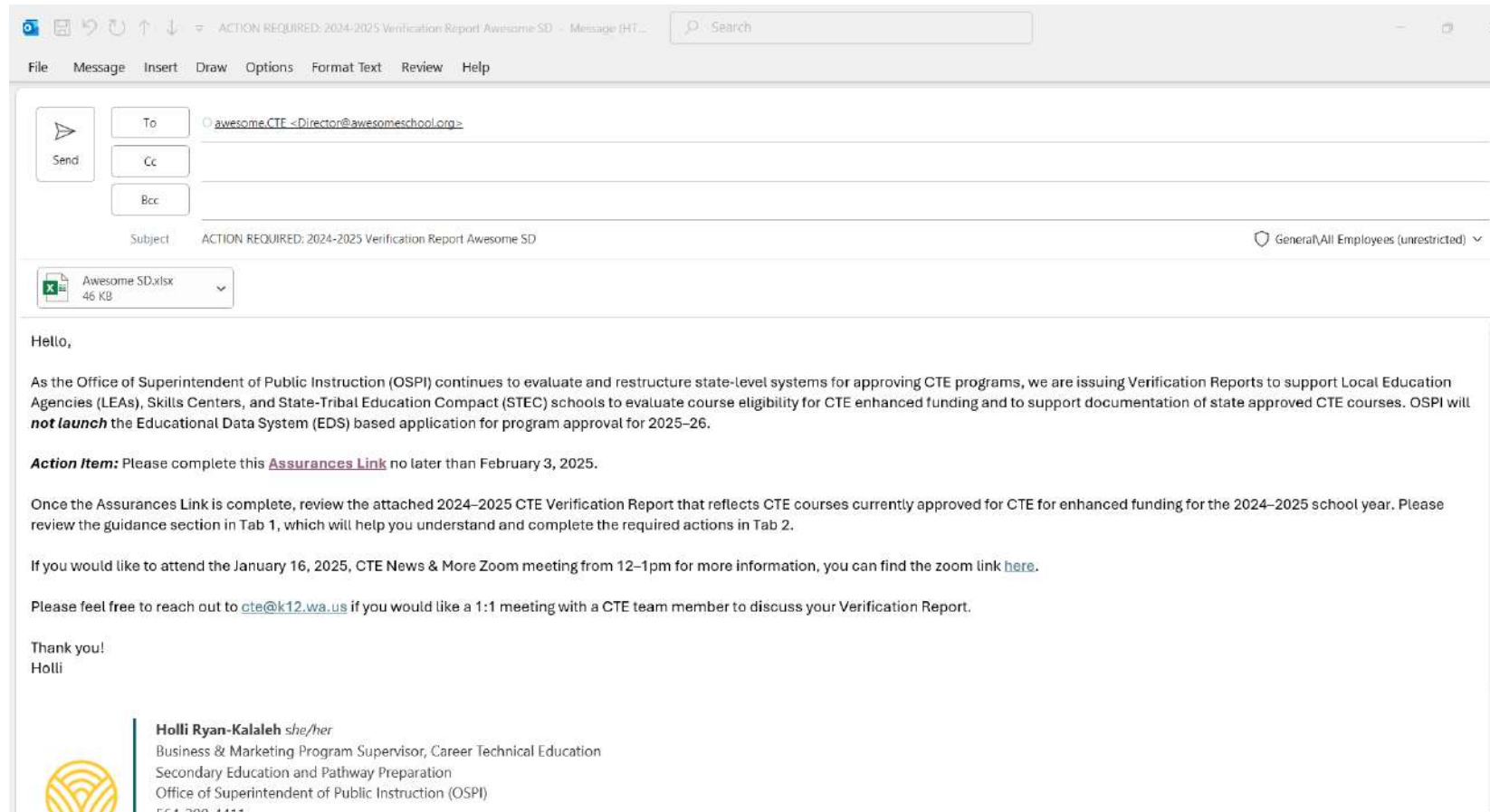

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Verification Report Overview

Reports have been prepared for all Local Education Agencies (LEAs), Skills Centers, and State-Tribal Education Compact Schools (STECs) with approved CTE Programs as reflected in OSPI approval systems. Course application information in the Educational Data System (EDS) and LEA enrollment reports for the 2023–24 school year were analyzed and evaluated for each LEA to develop the reports.

OSPI will NOT launch the Educational Data System (EDS) based application for program approval for 2025–26.



Report Purpose

- Review the report to determine the **status of CTE courses** and the actions that may be necessary for programs to be in **good-standing and eligible for enhanced funding**.
- **Note:** Courses are eligible for CTE enhanced funding from the date of course application approval.



Report Purpose, part 2

- Useful as a **comparison of resources** to ensure that all planned coursework to be offered during the school year is currently approved.
- Resources can be:
 - ✓ Local course catalog
 - ✓ CEDARS course catalog
 - ✓ Course master schedule
 - ✓ CTE course approval signature pages



Report Guidance

- ✓ Any courses being offered during the 2024–25 school year **not reflected** in the Verification Report **requires a new course application** in the Application Management section of EDS.
- ✓ Contact the appropriate local business office personnel to determine if the course was claimed for CTE enhanced funding. Section 9 of the **Enrollment Reporting Handbook** provides instruction on how to revise reported enrollment.

Course Verification Reports have been prepared for all Local Education Agencies (LEAs), Skills Centers, and State-Tribal Education Compact Schools (STECs) with approved Career & Technical Education (CTE) programs as reflected in the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) approval systems. Recipients will review these reports to determine the status of CTE courses and the actions that may be necessary for programs to be in good-standing and eligible for enhanced funding.

Guidance

Course application information in the Educational Data System (EDS) and LEA enrollment reports for the 2023–24 school year were analyzed and evaluated for each LEA to develop the verification reports. Verification reports may be useful as a comparison to resources such as the local course catalog, Comprehensive Education Data and Research System (CEDARS) course catalog, course master schedule, and CTE course approval signature pages to ensure that all planned coursework to be offered during the 2024–25 school year is currently approved.

Air courses being offered during the 2024–25 school year not reflected in the Verification Report requires new course applications in the Application Management section of EDS. Courses are eligible for CTE enhanced funding from the date of course application approval.
