Fourth Grade – Tuesday, June 11

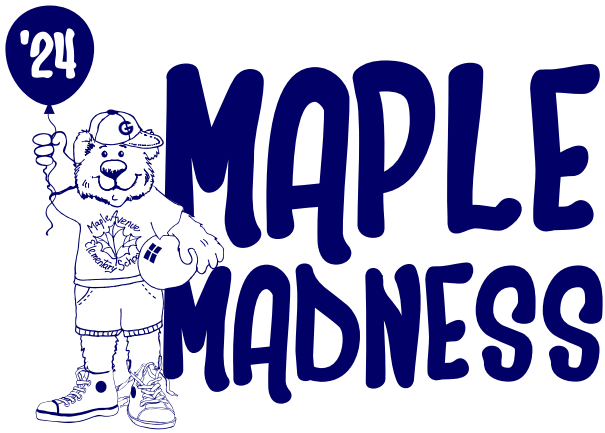
June 12th and June 14th will be designated as rain dates (if needed)
