DISMISSAL FORMS TO BE RETURNED

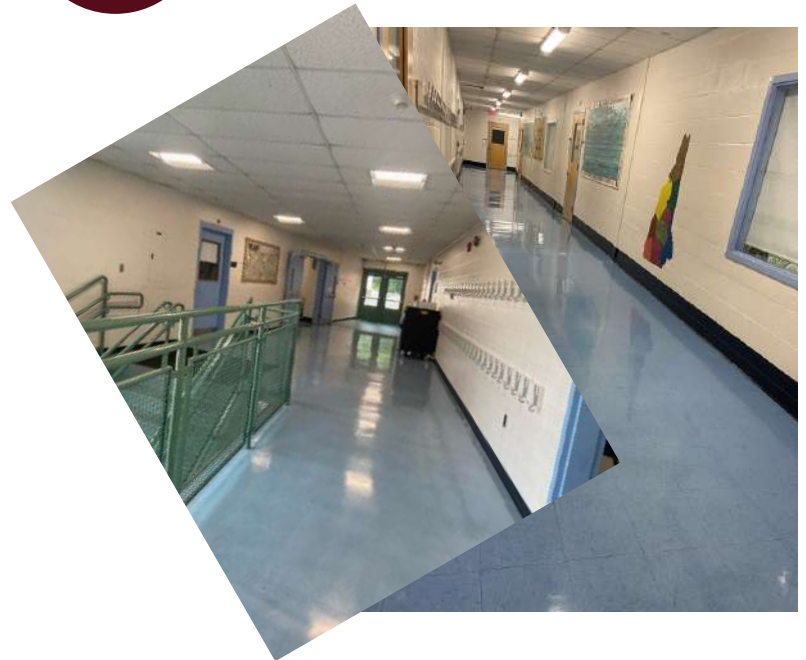
Parents/guardians will be receiving a Dismissal form via email next week. It is imperative you complete this form as soon as possible to ensure we have this information before students start class on September 3rd.
