PICK UP PROCESS

When picking up your children either in a car or "on foot" **you must have a sign with your child's last name, teacher and grade level.** This will help us make sure we get students to the correct adult as quickly and safely as possible. Thank you!



SEVERE WEATHER DISMISSAL PLAN

There will be times during the school year that we will need to keep students inside the building during dismissal due to severe weather such as heavy rain or a thunderstorm. On these days, we need parents/guardians to pick-up by car only. We will not be able to accommodate the on-foot traffic.

Students who walk alone off campus will be held at school until they are picked up by an adult or wait with us until the weather changes. Please call the school if you want your child's dismissal to change on these days.

YMCA AFTERCARE

If your child attends the YMCA Aftercare program either at Maple Avenue or at the YMCA, please make sure that you contact the YMCA directly if your child is not attending their program on a particular day. This helps make the dismissal process as quick and efficient as possible.



CHANGES TO DISMISSAL

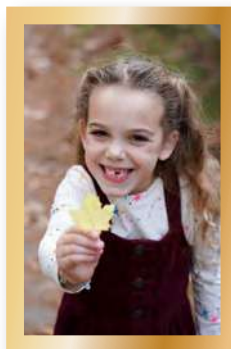

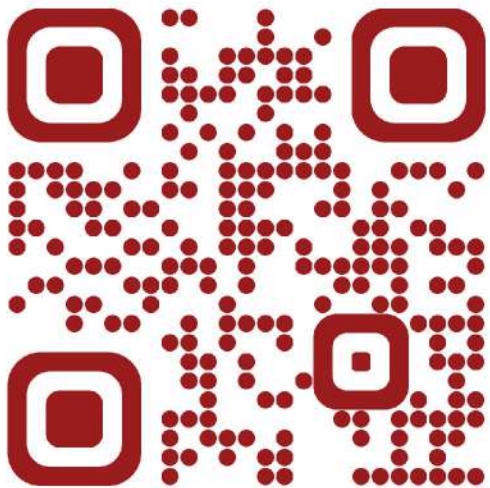

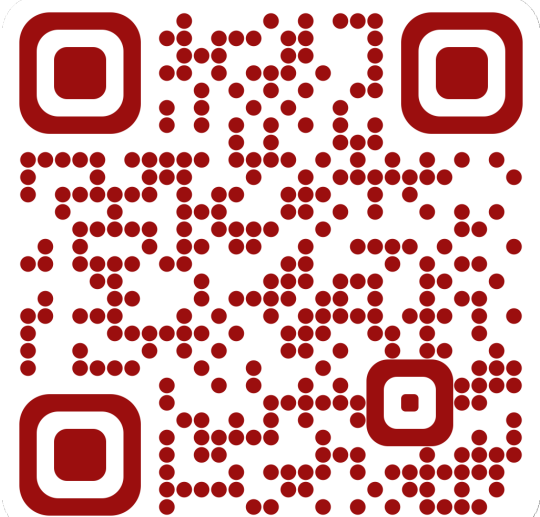
