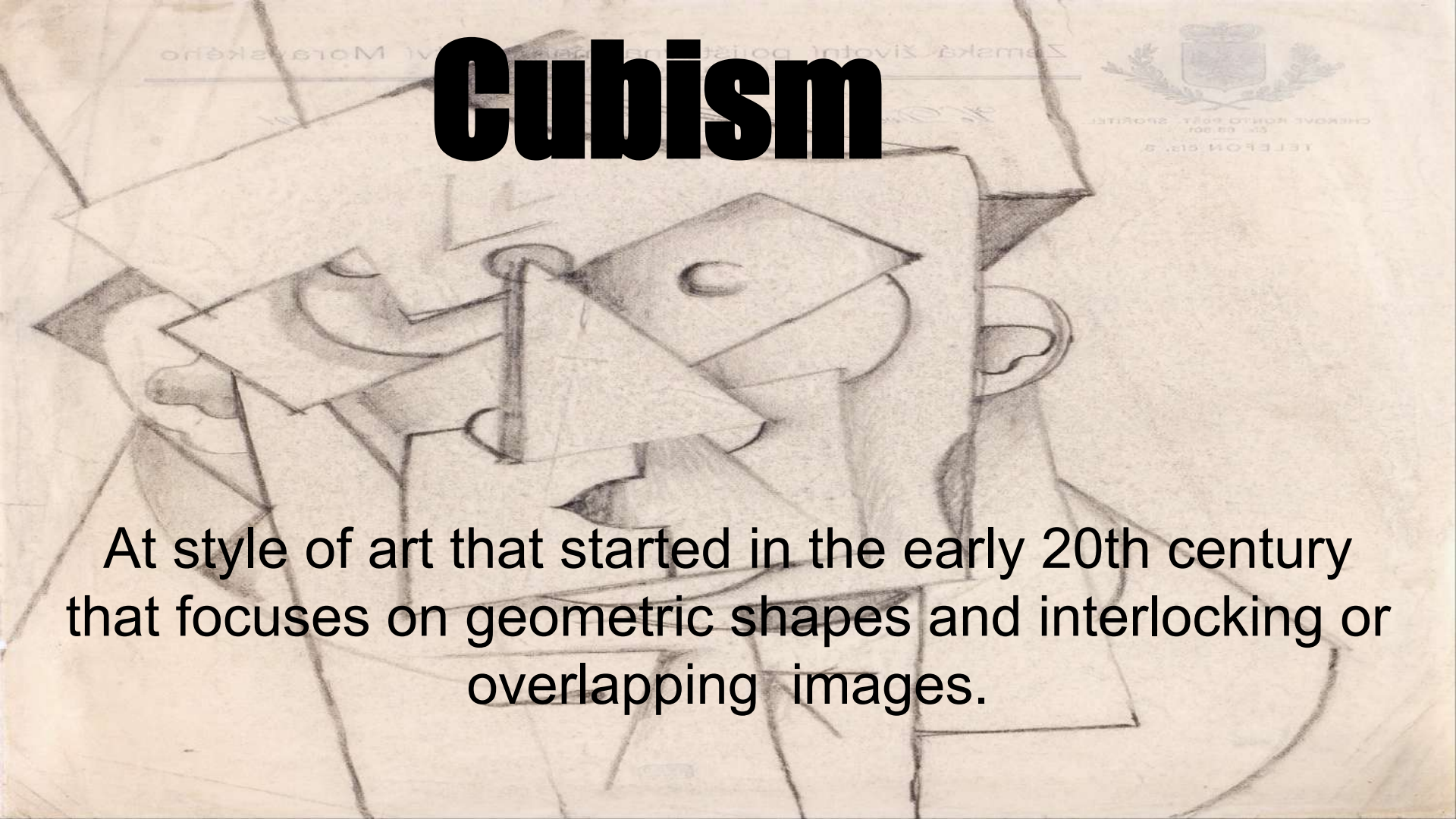
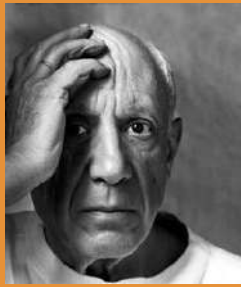


Cubism

Pablo Picasso(1881-1973)

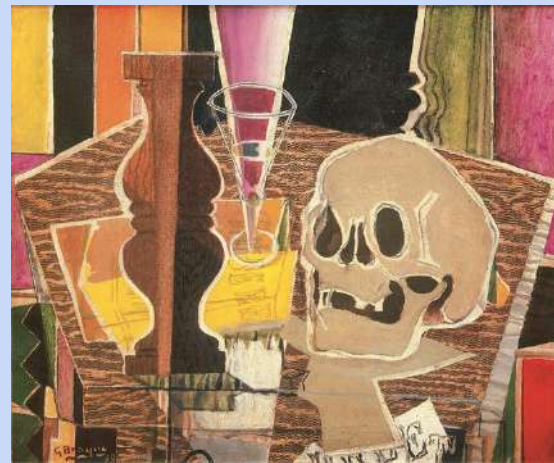

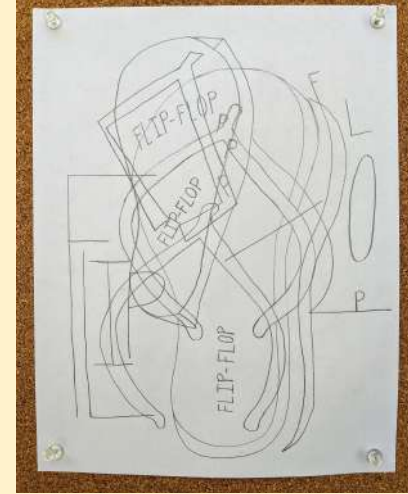
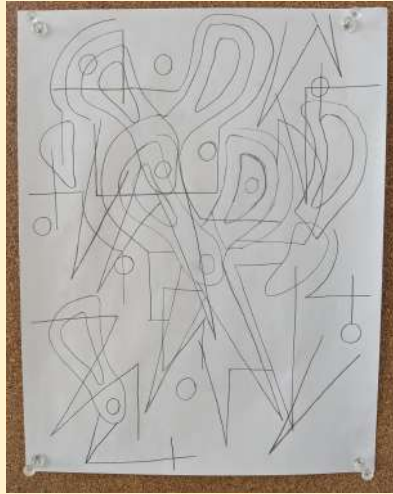
