This year our ELA teachers are using TopScore writing as well.

Students are identified for the remedial program based on ILEARN and NWEA scores. These students spend 25-30 minutes during their study hall in the BC Lab working on IXL for either ELA or Math. They are working on the IXL ILEARN skill plan.

Name and publisher of the school corporation/charter school's adopted reading and writing curriculum by grade level No set curriculum for CHS English; teachers pull from supplemental resources. Dual Credit and AP courses have a designed curriculum instructors must follow from either Indiana University or Ivy Tech.

Information on remedial programs provided by the school corporation by grade level: IXL is used as a remediation-based learning platform for grades 9-12 specifically in English. Instructors tailor remediation for students based off of their Fall NWEA scores. When PSAT scores are released, IT will upload students' PSAT scores to IXL and this will push out a new learning continuum for each student. For the Math department, students use ALEKS. This program is embedded into the student's newer textbook from McGraw-Hill (publisher). Students take a knowledge assessment at the beginning of each semester. Scores from this diagnostic provide a learning plan for the student. This outlines what skills the student is deficient in and provides tailored skill development to improve scores and retention.
