
Note: Foreign Language is not currently a graduation requirement; however, MA state universities require 2 years of the same foreign language... and they prefer 3+ years!

- The goal is to have schedules available to students by the end of the 2016-2017 school year.




GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) **BREAKDOWN WITH SAMPLE SCHOOLS**

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
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
Science and Tech. Ed./Engineering Dept. Course Offerings:

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



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
