MISSION STATEMENT: Through rigorous academics, integrative technology, expressive arts, and competitive athletics, the mission of Cuthbertson High School is to empower all students to be leaders in a changing global community.

DETAILS: Cuthbertson High School was established August, 2009 in Waxhaw, NC. There are approximately 1550 students enrolled in the school.

HONORS:

- NC Accountability Model: Exceeded Growth (based on the 2013-14 data)
- Graduation Rates: 98.5% for 2014-15; 97.58% for 2013-2014; > 95% for 2012-13; 96.9% for 2011-12; 96.9% for 2010-2011
- NC Honor School of Excellence: 2012-13; 2011-2012; 2010-2011; 2009-2010 (Program Discontinued 2013-2014)
- UCPS International School: 2010; 2011; 2012; 2013

DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS: Student must graduate with a minimum of 28 Carnegie credit units. Students who transferred to CHS during their high school year may have fewer.

SCHEDULE: Cuthbertson operates on a four by four block schedule. Each day, a student will have four, ninety-minute classes, earning a maximum of one credit per class.

GRADING SCALE: The state of North Carolina is in the process of transitioning the grading system for high school students. Until 2014, students were graded on a seven-point scale at Cuthbertson High School. Beginning the 2015-16 school year, all Cuthbertson students will be graded on a ten-point scale. The weighted GPA scale (for Honors and Advanced Placement classes) for students entering 9th grade in 2015 has also been revised. Please see the charts below for further clarification.

ONLINE COURSES – Students in all grades have the opportunity to take online courses through Union County Virtual (UCV) and/or North Carolina Virtual Public School (NCVPS.) Online courses are utilized when courses are not offered face-to-face at Cuthbertson High School, when scheduling is an issue, or when a student wants to take additional courses (as 5th block or as a summer course.) UCV and NCVPS both offer CP, Honors and AP courses.

CAREER AND COLLEGE PROMISE – CHS has partnered with South Piedmont Community College to offer college level courses through the Career and College Promise (CCP) program. Juniors and seniors have the opportunity to take community college classes through this dual enrollment program. CCP courses are weighted as honors level courses for weighted GPA purposes.

PASS / FAIL – Each year, students have the opportunity to take one elective course not required for graduation as a Pass/Fail. A course taken as a P/F will not be factored into the student's cumulative GPA.
