Parents of 1st and 2nd Graders Here's World Book Online!

During the last week of January in computer class, our **first graders** learned how to look for information, pictures, videos, and audio for animals of their choice using World Book (**WB**) Encyclopedia online! They just LOVED using WB so much I decided to invest half of each class period during the first week of February navigating World Book Encyclopedia more.

Second graders already researched animals and then Important People of America copying and pasting information from **WB** into a Word 365 file in December and January.

The district purchased a **license** for your child(ren) to use and enjoy this resource from any district device while in school without logging in with a username or password. From their homes, they will need to type a **username** and **password** to log in from their home computer, laptop, tablet, or smartphone

I plan to give each 1st and 2nd grader the district username and password to access **WB**. Please keep the username and password private because we only purchased enough access for students who attend Cornwall Lebanon School District schools.

The kids know how to access **WB** from my <u>www.CWLab.com</u> website. The **WB** log in screen looks like this:


