NEWS FROM THE NURSE



COVID-19 has increased our understanding on staying healthy. At the health office we appreciated all the prescreening you our doing as parents and guardians. Please feel free to call the health room if you have any concerns and questions on COVID-19. As always, please check with your primary care provider who knows your child best and can determine the care path you should take. If your child been seen and a COVID test performed, please contact the health room so we can make annotations of it. You should have the primary care provider fax to 717-389-1886.

<u>Medications:</u> Just a reminder that all medications needed during the school day (including over the counter medications and cough drops) MUST be delivered to the nurse or administrative office by an adult and must have parent/doctor signed medication order.

Please look at the <u>CLSD web site</u> if you have a student that will be seen for a well-child exam or dental exam. The nursing office will accept the forms now, and will be sending hard copies home in the month of December for future 2nd and 5th grade students.

Health Screenings for September included hearing screenings KG-3rd and vision and growth screenings for all students. If your child had difficulty with screenings, you would have been notified.

Nurses Needed

Please note the Cornwall-Lebanon School District is in need of nursing substitutes for school offices and for field trips. Applicants must have an active nursing license, either a RN or LPN and Basic Life Support Provider Card. If you have a nursing degree and have the qualifications/clearances to volunteer, please contact the district at 717-272-2031 or apply on the district website.



Head lice commonly occurs among school-age children. Infestations do not pose serious health risks but are associated with a high level of anxiety among parents. Your help in inspecting your child's hair at least weekly throughout the school year for the presence of head lice would be greatly appreciated. We suggest the following procedures for inspecting your child for head lice:

- Under bright light, begin looking at the back of the head just above the neck area.
- Part the hair section by section and look closely for head lice or nits (eggs). Lice are tiny and difficult to see, but they can be up to 1/8 inch in size. Eggs, also known as nits and are tiny, white-colored, round or oval shapes, will usually be located near the scalp.
- Depending on the length and thickness of the hair, it should take 5 and 15 minutes to properly inspect a child's head.

If you suspect your child is infested with head lice, the American Academy of Pediatricians (AAP) recommends consulting with your pediatrician or primary care provider for treatment options and guidance. Also, please contact the school nurse directly to help maintain confidentiality, assist with treatment and to clear the student to return to classroom.

Please contact me if you have any medical concerns related to your child. Non-urgent health concerns may be sent to student's e-mail as noted in the skyward program. 

The Skylert automated notification system also will be used to contact parents/guardians during
