HELP WANTED

Please note that the Cornwall-Lebanon School District is in need of Certified School Nurses and/or nursing substitutes for school offices and for field trips. Applicants must have an active nursing license, either a RN or LPN and Basic Life Support Provider Card. If you have a nursing degree and have the qualifications/clearances, you should contact the district office at 717-272-2031 or apply on the district website.





Lifelong habits begin at home. Make dental health part of your daily routine and share theses reminders with whole family:

- Brush your teeth twice a day with fluoride toothpaste, especially after breakfast and before bedtime. Drinking water after eating also helps to clear your teeth of food particles
- Floss every day. An adult should help children under the age of eight to floss. Older children should be ready to floss on their own.
- Limit the number of times you eat snacks, especially the sticky ones and long lasting ones.
- Visit a dentist regularly for a routine checkup and a cleaning
- Protect your teeth by wearing a mouth guard when playing sports.
- Do not forget to change your toothbrush regularly, and after an illness.
- Sweet snack facts:

Eating many snacks with sugar may cause cavities. Every time you eat sugar, plaque in your mouth mixes with the sugar make acid. The acid hurts the teeth and causes decay over time. This can be painful.

Dr. Yocum will be doing school physicals on February 10th for students who parents requested for their kindergarten/new students. Dr. Kaila Arnold will be doing dental exams on February 4th for students in kindergarten, new students and 3rd grade who parents requested school dental examinations.

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION



PARENT ORIENTATION WILL BE HELD AT 6 PM. THURSDAY. FEB. 17. 2022. IN ALL FOUR ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS.

ENTRANCE AGE REQUIREMENTS

For a child to enter kindergarten this fall in the Cornwall-Lebanon School District, she or he must have reached the age of five (5) BEFORE September 1. A child must have reached the age of six (6) BEFORE September 1 to be enrolled in first grade. This site contains information for your child to be registered for kindergarten in the Cornwall-Lebanon School District. Please take some time to acquaint yourself with the registration process. If, after reading this, you have questions or concerns, please 272-2031. call (717) Kindergarten registration involves three steps. The first step is to complete an enrollment application online using the link below. When we receive your application, we will send you an email with more information about the next steps in the process. The final step is scheduling in-person an registration kindergarten appointment at the District office.

STEP 1 - ONLINE ACCOUNT& KINDERGARTEN ENROLLMENT APPLICATION

Application If this is your first child to be enrolled in the school district, please complete this short web form to create an online Skyward Family Access account. After creating your account, you will receive an automated email asking you to complete the kindergarten enrollment application. Please complete and submit the application to continue the registration process. If you have a student currently enrolled in the school district, please log into your Skyward Family Access and click the "Online Student Registration" button on the left navigation menu to start the enrollment process.

STEP 2 - KINDERGARTEN PARENT ORIENTATION

Parent Orientation will be held at 6 PM, Thursday, Feb. 17, 2022, in all four elementary schools.

STEP 3 - REGISTRATION

At registration, you will be meeting in person with school district registration personnel to review enrollment papers. The registration process will take place at the Cornwall-Lebanon School District Office, 105 E. Evergreen Road, Lebanon, PA, 17042. You will receive an email with a link to schedule your appointment.

Please bring the following to THIS appointment:

- · Your child's immunization record
- Your child's birth certificate
- Proof of residency (bring one of the following: Deed, Lease Agreement, Mortgage Statement or Property Tax Statement)

Additional forms that will be needed to complete your child's registration:

- Physical Exam
- Dental Exam
- If applicable: Custody order, CLSDapproved guardianship form, CLSDapproved shared housing form.

NOTE: Cornwall-Lebanon School District Guardianship Affidavits and Shared Housing Affidavits, available at the District office, must be submitted and approved prior to the start of the school year.


