The season for Destination Imagination begins in September and concludes at the end of March. <u>All teams</u> participate in the Regional Tournament mid-March--there are wrap up/debrief meetings held after Regionals concludes for all teams. There is a possibility that teams advance to the State Tournament which is held in mid-April and/or Globals which is held the week before Memorial Day weekend. Practices to prepare for these competitions are held weekly. Every team member is an invaluable asset to the whole team and is required at every practice and tournament date.
