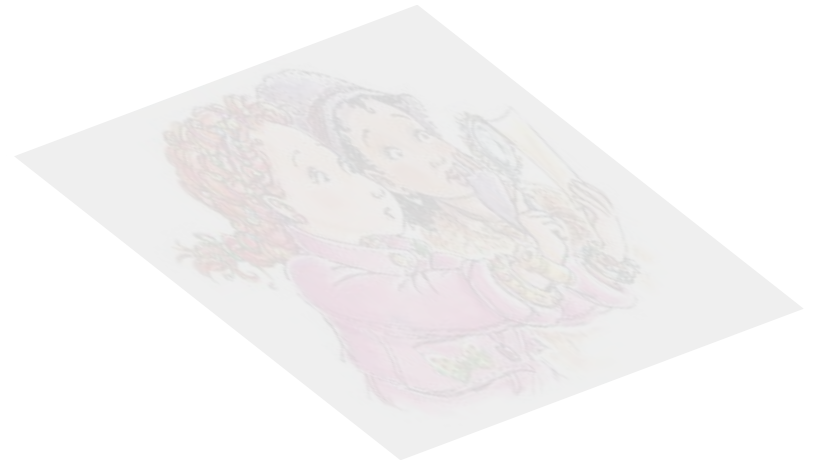

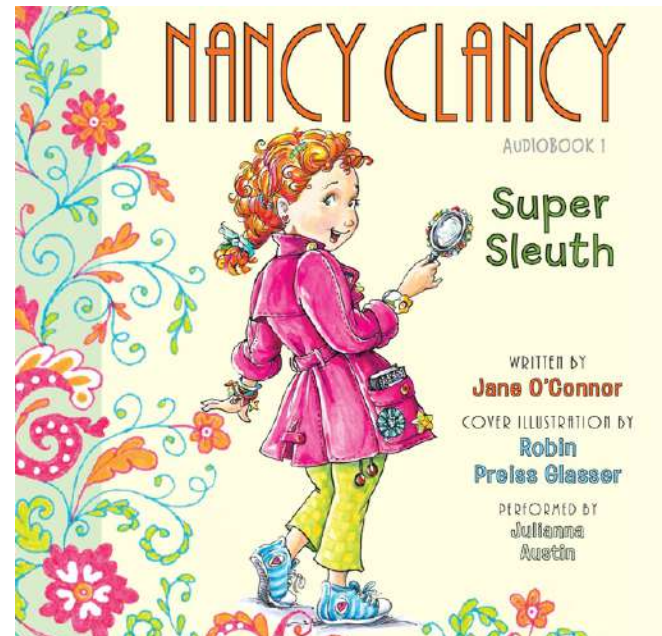
Genre: Fiction/Mystery
