

Daniel Mulvey Memorial Scholarship

Student Government and the teachers are partnered in sponsoring a scholarship in memory of our former welding instructor Mr. Daniel Mulvey. Teachers contribute funds for every Friday that they “dress down.” This money accumulates each year to form the scholarship fund. One scholarship will be presented this year to a deserving student in any shop area. If enough money is collected, an additional scholarship will be given. In order to qualify for this scholarship, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Have received an acceptance letter from a trade or postsecondary school. Proof of registration at a trade school or college must be provided before a check is issued.
2. Start classes within 6 months of graduation.

Applicants will be evaluated on the following basis:

1. Academic performance (current GPA)
2. Service to school and community since grade 9
3. Response to an essay (both content and correctness)
4. Financial need

Points will be given in each area and then added to determine the winners. Be sure to list all activities you have taken part in both in and out of school since 9th grade. Note positions of leadership. Be sure to spend time and effort on your essay. It is worth up to 25 points.
