- The Supreme Court building
- Make sure the laws are fair
- Keep job for life until they retire
- There are 9 justices
- Nominated by President
- Highest Court in USA





# The Legislative Branch

- Congress makes the law
- Meets in Capitol building

## House of Representatives

- 435 members
- 2 year terms

## Senate

- 100 members
- 6 year term



# The Executive Branch

- President is the head
- Serves for 4 year term
- Makes sure laws are carried out
- Armed forces
- White House
- Can sign to make a bill a law from congress or veto it.



# President

- Must be born in USA
- Must be 35 years old
- Could be a man or woman
- 4 year term
