

David Hockney: Joiner/ Montage Photography



A **photomontage** is a series of individual photographs, collectively arranged together to create a single image. Photomontage is like a jigsaw of pictures.



You will create a **EVERYDAY MOMENT** joiner photograph using PIC COLLAGE (free app) on your phone or IPAD. Joiner photographs combine multiple viewpoints of a single subject, images are overlapping and use a freestyle format to create a photo collage. In the early 1980's, English painter **David Hockney** began creating intricate photo collages that he called "**joiners**". His earlier collages consisted of grid-like compositions made up of Polaroid photographs.



Step 1: Choose an object in your house or backyard. Example: clock, flower, guitar, kettle, food, sport equipment



Step 2: Stand in one place. Take a minimum of 9-12 photograph of the object using your phone or IPAD

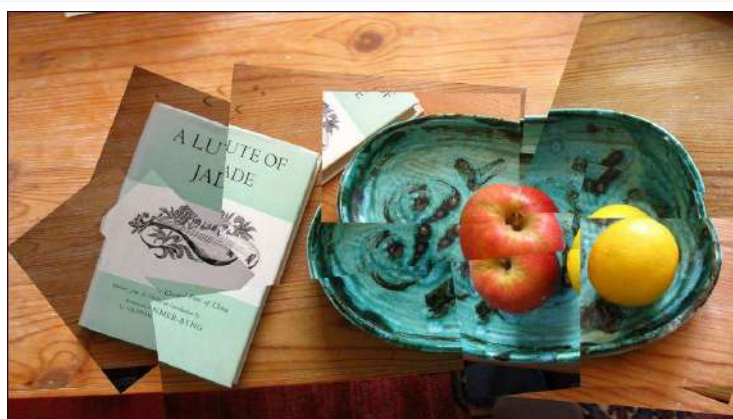
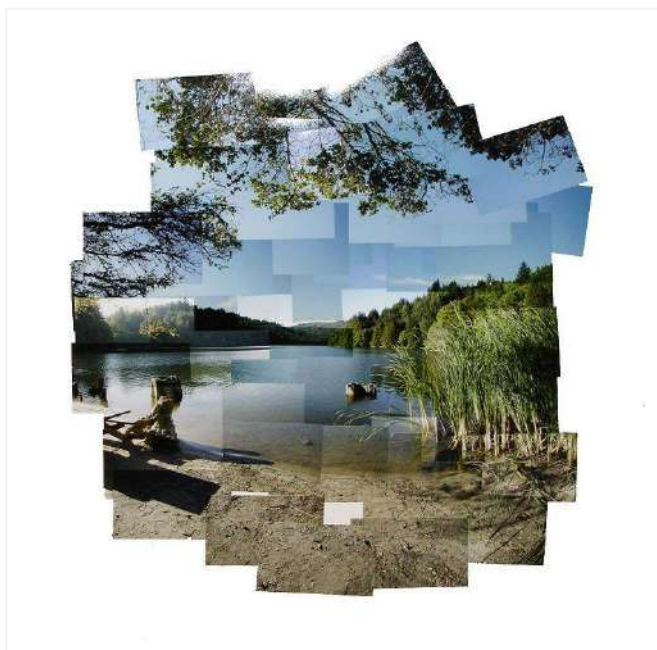

Step 4: Using the freestyle photo placement on PIC COLLAGE move the photos to create a joiner Still Life photo
